- **Fill light** - This light makes the ambiance in the scene and helps soften shadows built by the key light.

Step 4: Light the Green Screen

When you finish setting up the correct lighting for your subject, place the lights to focus on the green screen. Every source of illumination must have the same distance from each other and at similar angles. This practice is the best technique to ensure even lighting.

Step 5: Get Correct Exposure for the Green Screen
