	Task
	<p>Go to Google Drive and create a folder called:</p> <p><b>“2018 Work”</b></p>
	<p>While in the “2017 Work” folder, tap the <b>+</b> button and</p> <p><b>upload</b></p> <p>...items that you want to keep. <b>Please do not upload more than 10 items at once.</b> Files created using Pages, Keynote or Numbers should be exported to Drive from the app itself.</p>
	<p>Go to <b>Notability</b> and turn on the setting,</p> <p><b>“Sync to Google Drive.”</b></p>
	<p>Go to <b>Explain Everything</b> and</p> <p><b>export</b></p> <p>...projects to Google Drive. After you export, <b>be sure to move those items to your “2017 Work” folder.</b></p>

	<p>Go to <b>Swift Playgrounds</b> and</p> <h1>upload</h1> <p>...coding modules to Google Drive. This can be done using the “sharrow” in the top-left corner of the app’s home screen.</p>
