September 2023

November 2023

In November we donated gifts to Readington Social Services. This is the Angel Tree tag program that we have participated in for years. On top of twenty recipients, we received gift cards, extra gifts, and wrapping paper! There was also a food drop off for Thanksgiving, but we forgot to get a picture.

However, we filled up the large bin, so there was a good amount of donations!



January and February 2024

Another successful start to the year with diaper donations and incontinence products for adults. Over 1400diapers were collected! We also asked for gift cards or monetary donations for Meals on Wheels for February's communion offering.





We also held a food drive at our local supermarket, Bishops. There were many car loads of items collected, as well as monetary donations. These donations went to Starfish as well as Loaves of Love food pantries. The local Girl Scout troop also helped us with this food drive.



March 2024

With the success of the clothing give away in the fall, we decided to hold one again in the spring during the community Easter egg hunt. There were over twenty nice coats given away, plus beautiful dresses and suits, as well as everyday clothing like jeans and sweatshirts as well as shoes and purses. Some people also paid it forward and donated to the church, collecting \$170.00 from jewelry as well as the clothing donations. Hygiene products were also collected for Readington Social Services as a communion offering in March.

this time and we had a great response from the community. The proceeds were split with Starfish and Loaves of Love food pantries.





There was also another clothing give away during our annual East Whitehouse yard sale. September's monetary communion offering of close to \$300.00

October 2024

The October communion offering raised \$1400.00 and was donated to UMCOR for relief in North Carolina from Hurricane Helene \$1400.00

We also put together gift boxes for Operation Christmas Child. These shoeboxes were decorated by our local Girl Scout troop and filled with toys and school supplies as well as some hygiene products for children in less privileged areas. Samaritan's Purse is the charity behind this mission.
