

Possible Course Sequence for Students Entering the Program as Juniors

Please note that due to the required sequencing of courses, it is not possible to finish all requirements for a secondary science license in two years. Students who enter the program as juniors without any of the required courses already completed will need to student teach in the fall semester following their fourth spring.

*Courses in **bold** must be taken in sequence indicated. Unbolded courses can move to different semesters as available without regard to prerequisites or sequencing*

Fall

EDUC 4060* Classroom Interactions (3)

(5 hours / week practicum)

Fall Only, prereq for 4023 and 5385

Spring

EDUC 4023* Differentiating Instruction (3)

(4 hours / week practicum)

Spring Only, 4060 is a prereq

EDUC 4050 Knowing and Learning (3)

EDUC 5375* Problem-Based Instruction (3)

(6 hours / week practicum)

Spring Only, 4060 is a prereq

Fall

EDUC 4513 Education and Practice (2)

EDUC 4712 Secondary Student Teaching (10)

EDUC 4513 and EDUC 4712 must be taken together concurrently with full-time student teaching. No other classes may be taken during this semester.
