Teachers can click on these links and download the worlds to their computers. When one double clicks on the links, the world will open up in Minecraft Education Edition. The share settings on these worlds are anyone with the link can view.

World Links	World Descriptions
<u>Build Zones X24</u>	This world has 24 individual build zones that can be used for any purpose.
<u>Build Zones with Colored Doorways</u>	This world can be used for multiple purposes.
<u>Build Zones X8 with Lobby</u>	This world has a lobby area with 8 building zones.
<u>Build Zones 16 with Lobby</u>	This world has 16 build zones that begin in a lobby. Students can teleport to the build zone but then are not able to teleport back to the lobby or enter other build zones.
<u>Build Zones X28</u>	This world has 28 individual build zones that can be used for any purpose.
<u>Build Zones X28 Aquarium H20 world</u>	This world has 28 individual aquarium zones
<u>Main Soil World 3rd Grade</u>	This world helps students learn about and demonstrate their learning of the layers of soil.
<u>Main Treehouse Design Challenge</u>	This Treehouse Design Challenge world has deny blocks under the directions so that students can't accidentally break them.
