"SUPER ME!" Lower School Script 2025

SLIDE 1 - TITLE PAGE

SCENE ONE.

"SUPER ME!" is a live training program in the form of a theatrical show designed to help lower school kids fight against bullying and deal with social emotional learning issues. On stage is a giant video screen playing a series of videos for the main actor and audiences to interact with. The presentation is controlled by the main actor, host and lead trainer of the program, Sarge.

SLIDE 2 - TITLE AND INTRODUCTION

INT- THEATER OR STAGE WITH ONE TABLE CENTER, GIANT VIDEO SCREEN STAGE RT OR CENTER MID AND PROPS (THOR'S HAMMER, SMALLER TABLE WITH LOCK, FOO CAN, AND X-RAY VISION GLASSES FOR MAGIC TRICKS.) USE LARGER TABLE CENTER STAGE IF SMALLER TABLE IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR PROPS.

SARGE Hello everyone! Welcome to the Super Me Super Hero Anti-bullying Training Program!I'm your host and lead trainer, "Sarge!" What's my name?

AUDIENCE: SARGE!

SARGE: I can't hear you!

AUDIENCE: Sarge!

SARGE: Today you will be challenged in ways you've never dreamed of. Some of you will succeed and others will fail. But do not worry, we will all succeed in finding ways to fight against bullies. Now, you will be facing three types of challenges. First, there will be super hero challenges—things like super human strength, with Thor's hammer! There will be X-ray vision with our super x-ray vision glasses. There will be aquakinesis—the ability to move water with just your mind—and telekinesis—the ability to move objects with your mind. You'll also be facing a virtual challenge where we'll be helping a young boy

escape from bullies in a comic book world. And you'll also be learning a dance in four parts. It's a hip-hop dance. It's fun! Don't worry if you don't get it. It's just for fun. Let's see... are you guys ready to go? Let's see what our first challenge is going to be. I'm sure it's a superpower challenge. Yes, indeed!

SLIDE 3 - SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE - TELEKENISIS TITLE

SARGE: Do you guys think you have the ability to move objects with your mind?

AUDIENCE: YES!

SARGE: It's called Telekinesis. What's it called?

AUDIENCE: Telekinesis!!

SARGE: Alright, alright. I usually use telekinesis to check and see how much superpower we have collectively. That means together. I need you to all take a second to focus. Look at the red cup. Keep your eyes on the red cup. I need you guys to just follow my direction.

SLIDE 4 - TELEKENISIS MUSIC

(make sure to build with intensity)

SARGE: We're gonna breathe together, deep breaths. Every time the

pulse comes... Deep breath in... Blow it out. Big breath in... Blow it out. Big breath in... Now, focus... Concentrate... I need you to lift that cup up. Concentrate! Try to move it a little bit just an inch You've got this. Come on, focus! Focus!

(THE CUP MOVES)

Woah! Give yourselves a hand. Good job, guys, good job! Awesome. Let's see what our next challenge is gonna be. Oh, yes, another super power challenge. Here we go.

SLIDE 5 - SUPERHUMAN STRENGTH

SARGE: It's probably going to be SuperHuman Strength. Who thinks they can lift what no man dreams of lifting? Who thinks they can lift Thor's Hammer?

AUDIENCE: Me!

SARGE: Impossible! Oh let's see... let's see... let's see. (searching ad libs)

SARGE selects a volunteer and has them sit down on the edge of the stage or stand nearby while SARGE tells the story of Thor's hammer.

SLIDE 6 - PICTURE OF THOR

SARGE: I want to tell everybody the story of Thor's Hammer. You see, Thor didn't always have this hammer. No... in fact this hammer was born out of an act of bullying. You see, Thor's worst nemesis, his biggest problem, was his own little brother- Loki.

SLIDE 7 - PICTURE OF LOKI

What's his name?

AUDIENCE: Loki!

SARGE: Yeah! Loki was very jealous of Thor. He was jealous about everything, and he was really jealous about his friend.

SLIDE 8 - PICTURE OF SIF

SARGE: She had beautiful blonde hair, so Loki snuck in one night and cut off her hair. Thor, when he found out the next morning, was furious!

SLIDE 9 - THOR CHASING LOKI

SARGE: So, he got up and chased him all around. When he finally got Loki, Loki said "Ah! No, no! Don't hurt me! Don't hurt me Thor! I can fix this! I'll go down to the Cave of Dwarves. I'll get them to make a beautiful head of hair for her and I'll get

them to make a weapon for you. Thor thought for a little while, and against his better judgment he agreed and let Loki go.

SLIDE 10 - LOKI WITH DWARVES AND HAMMER

SARGE: So, Loki went down to the Cave of Dwarves. He got the dwarves to make a beautiful head of hair, and he got them to build... Thor's hammer- right here!

SLIDE 11 - PICTURE OF THOR WITH HAMMER

SARGE: Well, he took it back to Thor. Thor loved the hair! There was no problem there, but when he tried to pick up the hammer... could he pick it up?

AUDIENCE: No!

SARGE: No! He tried again... Could he pick it up?

AUDIENCE: No!

SARGE: No! He tried again... Could he pick it up?

AUDIENCE: No!

SARGE: No... but you know what?

SLIDE 12 - PICTURE OF INSCRIPTION

SARGE: Then Thor looked down on the side of the hammer, and he saw an inscription (some words). The words said: Whosoever holds this hammer, if he be worthy, shall possess the power of Thor. Thor thought: I am worthy! So, he tried to pick it up again, but could he pick it up?

AUDIENCE No!

SARGE: And then he stood up and shouted: I am worthy!

SLIDE 13 - PICTURE OF THOR PICKING UP HAMMER

SARGE: And with that, Thor picked up the hammer with power, thunder, lightning and superhuman strength!

Let's see my friend...

SARGE refers to the selected child and asks the audience...

SARGE: Do you think he/she can do it?

AUDIENCE: Yeah!

SARGE Stand up! Here we go! Let's give it a shot. Come on over here.

SARGE brings the selected child over to the hammer.

Let me hear you say: I am worthy!

KID and AUDIENCE: I am worthy!

SARGE: You don't sound like you're very worthy... You've got to say it like you mean it!

KID AND AUDIENCE: I am worthy!

SARGE directs the child to place their hands on Thor's hammer.

SARGE: Say I am worthy!

KID AND AUDIENCE: I am worthy!

SARGE: I am worthy!

KID AND AUDIENCE: I am worthy!

Sarge directs the child to pick it up, clarifying to pick it straight up, and the child fails.

SARGE: Aww, give him/her a hand for trying! Give him/her a hand everybody!

SARGE assists the child off of the stage and reaffirms them with words (good job, nice try, etc.)

SARGE: (calling out to the child) Don't worry! By the end of the show, I bet you can do it! I bet you surely can do it by the end of the show! Give another big round of applause!

[Applause]

SARGE: Let's see... who else would like to try? Let me see... who thinks they got this?

SARGE selects another child from the crowd, and directs them onto the stage.

SARGE: Come on down! Give him/her hand everybody!

[Applause]

Do you think he/she can do it?

AUDIENCE: (replies)

SARGE: Let's see... What's your name?

CHILD: (responds)

SARGE: Okay, come right over here. Stand close up, put two hands

on. Everybody shout: I am worthy!

KID and AUDIENCE: I am worthy!

SARGE: (to kid) You shout: I am worthy!

KID: I am worthy!

SARGE: Let me hear you shout it!

KID and AUDIENCE: I am worthy!

SARGE directs the child to pick it up.

SARGE: Pick it up! ... He/she did it! Give him/her a hand everybody!

[Applause]

SARGE: Good job! High five! Have a seat!

SARGE assists the child off of the stage.

SARGE: Give another big hand everybody!

[Applause]

SARGE: Boys and girls, I tell you this story because I want you to know something. You don't need superhuman strength to beat bullies! It's not strength of the muscle; it's strength of the mind and strength of the heart! I'll tell you more as we go along, you'll see. Let's see here... what's our next challenge?

SLIDE 14 - BE KIND ALL THE TIME

SARGE: Five simple words: Be kind all the time! Let me hear you say it!

AUDIENCE: Be kind all the time!

SARGE: Let's hear it: Be kind all the time! Say it with me:

AUDIENCE: Be kind all the time!

SARGE: Five simple words. If we were kind all the time we wouldn't have a problem. Remember from day to day, just try to be kind.

SLIDE 15 - PHYSICAL TRAINING

SARGE: Let me see... It's physical training! Get up everybody, we've got to move! Come on, get up, get up, get up! It's time to learn the Super Me dance! Here we go, just follow me! Let's go! Ready:

SARGE explains the steps.

SARGE: One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight. Good, let's do it again.

SARGE does it again and the audience joins in.

SARGE: One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight. Again. One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight. Good job guys! Sit down, sit down. We'll practice it more in a bit! Let's see what our next challenge is!

SLIDE 16 - "GOOD CHOICE VS BAD CHOICE 8:58

SARGE: Oh, it's Good Choice, Bad Choice! Guys, we make decisions every day. Every time we make a decision, it has an impact. It affects what's going to happen to us. We can select the good thing to do or the bad thing to do. Let's take a look!

SLIDE 17 - KIDS KNOCKS OVER BLOCKS

SARGE: What would you do if someone messed with your play time and interrupted your play things by knocking over your blocks. What would you do? Raise your hands!

SARGE picks a child to answer.

SARGE repeats back what the kid says ...

SLIDE 18 - GOOD CHOICE BAD CHOICE WHAT TO DO

SARGE: Good... Let me show you something. Let me tell you something. When I get mad, and I want to lash out... I want to try to hit somebody or shout... you know what I do? I take a big breath in. Everybody do it with me now! I do it silently. Blow it out through your nose silently. Close your eyes. I close my eyes and I breathe in... and I blow it out. Breathe it in... blow it out. Breathe it in... long breath out. You feel yourself start to calm down? I always do, and then I make better choices! Open your eyes! So, first I do that, but what else could we do? Raise your hand. Tell me...

SARGE picks a child to answer.

SARGE responds to what is said and responds accordingly.

SARGE: We ask them politely to stop! Right? Would you hit them?

AUDIENCE: No!

SARGE: No... would you call them bad names?

AUDIENCE: No!

SARGE: No, no.Let's look at some more important things to go over. First, take a deep breath. Let me hear you say that:

SARGE and AUDIENCE: Take a deep breath!

SARGE: Keep breathing with your eyes closed until you calm down. Nicely ask the person to stop. That's right, ask them to stop!

SARGE listens to audience responses for a moment.

SARGE: And last but not least, who do we tell if we can't get them to stop?

SARGE listens to the audience's response.

SARGE: Tell a grownup! That's right. Tell a grownup! Say it: Tell a grownup!

AUDIENCE: Tell a grownup!

SARGE: Very good! You get some help. That's if they won't stop... Alright, let's move on.

SLIDE 19 - VIRTUAL TRAINING TITLE

SARGE: Let's see... (sound effect) Oh it's time for virtual training guys!

SLIDE 20 - MEET BILLY

SARGE: Here's who we're helping- Billy. Say hi Billy!

AUDIENCE: Hi Billy!

SARGE: Billy is a level two trainee. You are level one. Billy is getting ready to be transported into this comic virtual world, but Billy is also being bullied by a mean group of kids known as The Clash Clan! Let's meet them!

SLIDE 21 - CLAY

SARGE: This is Clash Clay. The Clash Clan, they're known for all kinds of things, but Clay is known for punching, pushing, kicking, really hurting people, yelling, cursing and name calling.

SLIDE 22 - KAT

SARGE: This is Kat. Kat is known for tripping, pinching, biting, name calling and cursing!

SLIDE 23 - THUGGEE

SARGE: And this is Thuggee. Thuggee is a cyber bully. He uses his computer, his iPad or his phone to bully kids by calling them names and posting mean pictures and videos.

SLIDE 24 - VIRTUAL TRAINING MAP

SARGE: Now, what's going to happen is this: They will all be magically transported to a virtual training course. The training course begins with the Maze of Madness. I think we're going to try to help Billy with some x-ray vision. If they escape that, then they go to the Desert of a Thousand Roads, where they have to make some tough decisions—just like you might if you're being bullied. And then if they make it out of there, they go to the Whispering Forest of Doubt, and that's where they hear all of those mean things… all of those names they've been called and they can't get out of their head. Last, they end up at Em's Castle, and that's where they have to find the secret portal to get back home. You guys with me? You understand?

AUDIENCE: Yeah!

SLIDE 25 - SUPER ME SUPER POWER BOOK

SARGE: All right, cool! Let's find out a little bit more about what's going to happen here. Billy has a book. It's called the Super Me Superpower Book. If he loses that book, he can't get home. It's the key to the portal. He's got to keep that book. It also allows us to talk to him, but if somebody else is nearby... well he can't hear us. It blocks the signal. So, he's got to have that book at all times. Let's see what happens next my friend. Let's find out what bullying is.

SLIDE 26 - DEFINING BULLIES: REPEAT OFFENDERS

SARGE: It's a repeat offense. Something that happens over and over and over again to the same person. There's Billy.

Audience watches bullies in action in a short clip.

SARGE: Saved by the bell! Hey, did you see that girl stand up right between Billy and the bully? She was trying to shut it down. That's called stepping up. You can step up if you'd like, but if you're going to do something like that, just make sure someone's got your back. She knew there was a teacher nearby so if there was real trouble she could call for help. Don't put yourself in danger, but if you can help, definitely do. All right, let's see what's next.

SLIDE 27 - DEFINING BULLIES - WORD WEAPONS

(Timing with video is important)

Kids watch a video of kids using devices to bully while SARGE speaks.

SARGE: These here are word weapons. Words can hurt just as much as any kicking, punching or biting. In fact, they're worse because they don't go away. In this case we're talking about cyber bullying. You know that everybody pretty much has a phone these days. Raise your hand if you have a phone guys... or an iPad or computer. I bet you use that , right? Well, cyber bullying is when you use your phone or iPad to say mean things. They're saying things like "he's such a loser and wannabe", and they're talking about making a Facebook page talking about Billy himself, and how they'll post pictures on it and make fun of him with crazy pictures. Now it's not like Billy doesn't know... He knows exactly what's going on, and it doesn't go away at 3:30 or 4:00. We all go home, but when it's on the internet, everybody sees it all day and all night. I'll tell you something else ... every one of your phones... every one of your PlayStations, or your Switches, or your Xboxes... everything you use has a number hidden inside- deep inside it- and when you do something wrong, it can be traced back to you. It has a number that identifies who is using that device and where you're located. So please, be kind all the time. What did I say?

AUDIENCE Be kind all the time!

SARGE: Think before you do something. Make sure you're being kind, okay? Good job guys!

SLIDE 28 - STOP CYBER BULLYING

SARGE: All right, that's how we stop cyber bullying. That's what it's called: cyber bullying.

SLIDE 29 - GOOD CHOICE / BAD CHOICE NAME CALLING

Audience watches example video while SARGE Speaks

SARGE: But let's talk about when somebody's calling you names in real life, not in the virtual world.

SLIDE 30 - BULLIES CALLING KID NAMES

SARGE: What would you do if people were yelling at you and calling you bad names and making you feel bad? What do you do guys? Raise your hands. Here we go!

SARGE selects a child and listens to the selected child's response.

SLIDE 31 - WHAT TO DO IF SOMEONE IS CALLING YOU NAMES

SARGE: Give her/him a hand! I like that! One of my favorites is: ignore them. Say: ignore

AUDIENCE: Ignore!

SARGE: Do you know what that means? Just blow them off. Don't even pay attention. Walk away like "I'm not listening to you!" Don't let them have power over you. You know who you are! You're not what they say you are. You are what you believe you are. Just know inside that you have the power, not them! Okay? Walk away. What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Walk away!

SARGE: Right, ignore them. Walk away. And next, last but not least, we say it a lot: tell a grownup! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Tell a grownup!

SLIDE 32 - PHYSICAL CONTACT

SARGE: Good job guys, good job! All right, last but not least, the bullying we all think about. That's when you kick, punch, or hit. When you're trying to hurt someone physically. Watch this:

Physical bullying video plays with audio and audience watches.

SARGE: (in response to the video) Oh we've got a push! Looks like he's going to punch him. Hold on, he's got the Superpower Book! They're heading to the virtual world.

SLIDE 33 - TITLE GOOD CHOICE BAD CHOICE - PHYSICAL CONTACT

SARGE: Okay guys, let's talk for a minute. Good choice, Bad choice again!

SLIDE 34 - BULLIES BEATING KID UP

Video plays of bullies hitting and kicking while SARGE talks.

SARGE: What do you do when someone's trying to hit you? Do you hit them back?

AUDIENCE No!

SARGE: No! Do you know why? Because it only makes it worse. Because when the teacher comes or a grownup comes, they don't know who started it, and you'll probably be pointing at each other going: "He did it, he did it, he did it!", and they won't know. And, you'll get in trouble too. So, I'm going to give you some suggestions. I say block and walk! Let me hear you say: Block and Walk!

AUDIENCE: Block and Walk!

SARGE: Put your hands up like this.

(SARGE: puts hands in front of their face like a boxer)

SARGE: If someone tries to hit you, do like a karate guy does! Block! Block away- like this! Just knock their hands out of the way, block, and at the same time, walk away. While you're walking, I have something else to tell you. Yell and tell! What did I say?

AUDIENCE Yell and tell!

SARGE: Very good! That means call out for a teacher. "Someone get a teacher!" "Teacher, teacher! Get the principal!" Get somebody that's a grownup to help you out. "Walk and talk" is very important.

SLIDE 35 - PHYSICAL CONTACT RESPONSE OVERVIEW SLIDE

SARGE: Let's go back over these again. Hold on everybody. Block and walk! Walk away and yell for help. Tell a grownup.

SLIDE 36 - BLOCK AND WALK SLIDE

SARGE: Let's say it together!

SARGE and AUDIENCE: Block and walk!

SLIDE 37 - YELL AND TELL SLIDE

SARGE and AUDIENCE: Yell and tell!

SARGE: Good job guys! Good job. All right, let's get a move on... oh hold on!

Video of Billy plays.

SLIDE 38 - BILLY AT THE MAZE ENTRANCE

BILLY: Where am I?

SARGE: It's Billy! Hey Billy! Hey!

BILLY: Oh thank God you're there!

SARGE: You've got the book, you know what to do here. Right! You know what to do, Billy.

BILLY: Yes, Yes, I guess so.

SARGE: All right, get inside. You're at the maze. You've got to get inside. Tell him to get inside!

AUDIENCE: Get inside!

SLIDE 39 - BULLIES AT THE MAZE ENTRANCE

SARGE: And run! run! The bullies are coming. Run Billy, run! Oh, here come the bullies. Hold on guys, here they come!

CLAY: What the?

KAT: Where are we?

THUGGEE: What is this place?

CLAY: Where's the kid?

KAT: He must have gone in.

CLAY: Let's get him!

SARGE: Oh boy! Guys, we're going to have to help him.

SLIDE 40 - SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE X-RAY VISION

SARGE: It looks like it's a Superpower Challenge! Here, let's see... I need someone with x-ray vision. I'm sure of it! We've got to see through those walls and make sure we can get him through this! Who can help me out?

SARGE picks a new child from the audience.

SARGE: Give him/her your hands everybody! Come on down! Awesome! What's your name?

CHILD responds

SARGE: Awesome! (Child's name), you can wear some super cool glasses.

SARGE puts the glasses on the child.

SARGE: Look at this! Check them out! There you go. Everybody give him/her a hand everybody! Awesome. All right, come over this way.

SARGE guides the child to stand stage left of the screen to view it.

SLIDE 41 - X-RAY VISION - VOLUNTEER

SARGE: I want you to see if you can read this. Can you read that? Shout out what it says. Okay, shout it out and tell everybody.

CHILD: Help Billy!

SARGE: What did he/she say? Help Billy? Say it again, shout it out.

CHILD and AUDIENCE: Help Billy!

SARGE: Good. Concentrate, concentrate guys! Do you see it yet? Do you see Billy yet?... hold on... Do you see it yet? You've got to focus. Are you seeing it? I feel it...

SLIDE 42 - X-RAY VISION - HELP BILLY - REVEAL

SARGE: There it is. Help Billy! Give him/her a hand everyone! Help Billy. Good job. All right, focus. Now, we're going to need something else here.

SLIDE 43 - X-RAY VISION INTO MAP

SARGE: We're going to need to see the map. Focus. Concentrate. Do you guys see the map yet? Do you see it?

AUDIENCE: Yes!

SARGE: There it is! Give him/her a big round of applause everyone. Have a seat, have a seat! Good job.

SARGE ensures the child makes it off of the stage.

Maze animation plays along with a video.

SARGE: Okay. Billy is the green circle. The bullies are the red triangle. Billy, we're going to help you.

BILLY If they get to me, they're really going to hurt me.

SARGE: I know- we've got this- we'll help you. We'll tell you which way to go. Okay, go right. Tell him to go right!

AUDIENCE: Go right!

SARGE: Tell him to go left!

AUDIENCE: Go left!

SARGE: You're doing great! No wait, tell him the other way!

AUDIENCE: Other way, other way!

SARGE: Billy, you've got to keep moving!

SLIDE 44 - BULLIES ENTER MAZE

BULLIES: There he is! Wait up, Piggy! Let's get him.

SARGE: Oh... that's not good!

SLIDE 45 - MAZE - HELP BILLY OUT PT. 2

SARGE: Billy you've got to keep moving. Can you hear me Billy? Keep moving. Okay, all right, I'm going to tell you. Go right! Tell him to go right!

AUDIENCE: Go right!

SARGE: Now tell him to go right again!

AUDIENCE: Go right!

SARGE: Hurry up! Right here. You've got it! Go left! Tell him to

go left!

AUDIENCE: Go left!

SARGE: Keep moving Billy!

SLIDE 46 - BULLIES FREAKED OUT

BULLIES: Slow down, man. Do you even know how to get out of here? We've been running forever. Chill. Let's go this way.

SARGE: Oh good, they're slowing down.

SLIDE 47 - MAZE - HELP BILLY OUT PT. 3

SARGE: That's good! Billy, they're slowing. Can you hear me? They're slowing down. You've got to keep moving. Good. Keep ahead of them. You can't hear me. Good, keep going. We're moving along here. Go right!

AUDIENCE: Go right!

SARGE: Go! Let's go right! Hurry up! Left and left again!

AUDIENCE: Left!

SARGE: Go Billy! They're catching up. Tell him to hurry up!

AUDIENCE: Hurry up!

SARGE: All right, Billy. You've got it now. You've got to turn

right here. Tell him to go right!

AUDIENCE: Go right!

SARGE: Billy you've gotta keep moving. You're turning left right

here. Go down that way! Turn right! Tell him to hurry up!

AUDIENCE: Hurry up!

SARGE: Tell him to go right! Right, right, right!

AUDIENCE: Right!

SARGE: You've got it Billy. Tell him to hurry up, hurry up!

AUDIENCE: Hurry up!

SARGE: Go right, go left! Quick, they're catching up! Tell him

to go left!

AUDIENCE: Go left!

SARGE: Yeah, that's good! You'll see the door! Hurry up, hurry

up! WE GOT IT!

AUDIENCE: cheers

SLIDE 48 - BILLY EXITS MAZE AND MEETS COOLEY THE COYOTE

During this, SARGE pantomimes an attempt to reach Billy through a headset.

COYOTE: Hey, man. Get out of my light. You're choking my rays. You're stealing my tan, man.

BILLY: Woah, you are you?

COYOTE: I am the Coyote. Now get out of my grill so I can reach my MTP.

BILLY: MTP? What's that?

COYOTE: Maximum tan potential, bro. Can't you see?

BILLY: Sorry. Do you know which way is the way back?

COYOTE: Way back? Way back? You need to get way back out of my tanning space.

BILLY: If you don't tell me which way to go, those bullies are gonna get me and they're really gonna hurt me.

COYOTE: I don't know. Maybe you should just read the signs or something, hm?

BILLY: "Your Name Road. Go here." This makes no sense. They all say the same thing. Mister Fox, can you help me?

COYOTE: No can do, little buddy. The way is different for everyone. You gotta find it on your own.

BILLY: Wait, those kids, that quy, this book, maybe ...

COYOTE: You mean this book?

Coyote reaches for the book

SARGE: No, don't touch the book, no!

BILLY: Oh, man, where'd he go?

SARGE: He shouldn't have touched the book!

SLIDE 49 - WARNING SECURITY BREACH

Guys, we've got a security breach. Shut it down! It's okay. It was just a security breach. I'm not sure what that was...

SLIDE 50- SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE - X-RAY VISION TITLE PAGE

SARGE: It's okay guys, he's back on track! It's a Superpower Challenge! Let's see what we've got here guys... another Superpower Challenge! I bet it's x-ray vision!

SARGE: searches the crowd and finds a new kid to help and calls them up on to the stage.

SARGE: Give it up for him/her. What's your name?

CHILD: says his/her name

SARGE: repeats their name. Okay, try this! All right, you put on the glasses right here. Show them how cool you look! Give him/her a big round of applause everyone!

AUDIENCE: [applause]

SARGE: Great job!

SARGE: moves the child stage left of the screen to view it.

SLIDE 51 - X-RAY VISION - VOLUNTEER

SARGE: All right, focus and concentrate. Can you read that? What does it say?

CHILD: Stay away.

SARGE: He said stay away! Tell them, shout it out.

CHILD and AUDIENCE: Stay away!

SARGE: Good, all right. Let's do the reveal. Hold on... hold on...

SLIDE 52 - X-RAY VISION REVEAL - STAY AWAY

Do you guys see it yet? Do you see it? Stay away! Good job! Great job! Awesome, have a seat!

SARGE sees that the child makes it off of the stage

Stay away! Stay away! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Stay away!

SARGE: That's right! Stay away! Guys, it's simple. If you know the bully is close by, get away from them! If you know where they're going to go... down the hall ...stay away from them! If you know where they're at on the playground, stay away! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Stay away!

SARGE: That's right! Don't give them a chance! Just stay away. Good. All right, let's see what's next.

SLIDE 53 - PHYSICAL TRAINING TITLE SLIDE

SARGE: Oh, it's physical training! Get up! We've got to move! Let's go!

Audience stands up

SARGE: We're going to go a little faster. Are you guys ready? Here we go! 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8!

SARGE is leading them through the moves.

SARGE: Sit down guys! You're doing great. That's awesome! All right, let's see what's next. Let's see where we are here... hold on... all right.

SLIDE 54 - MAP IMAGE SLIDE

SARGE: Billy is in the Canyon Lands! The bullies have made it out of the maze. Let's try to connect with Billy. Everybody say Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

SARGE: Billy, are you there? Billy, come in. Billy? Billy?

Billy?

SLIDE 55 - BULLIES OUT OF MAZE

Video plays

THUGEE: We should head back ...

CLAY: Head back? That book is the only way home. Little piggy has the book. Let's go.

SARGE: Ah good ,they're arguing. It's slowing them down, that's great! Okay listen guys, let's try Billy again. Everyone say: Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

SLIDE 56 - BILLY EXITS THE DESERT

SARGE:Billy, can you hear me? Billy... Billy? I think something went wrong... hold on... we lost communication... hold on! Billy...Billy... Billy oh he's there. Hold on Billy. Billy, are you there?

SLIDE 57 - BILLY WITH CAN OF WATER

BILLY: Hey guys I'm really thirsty. I found this can... can of water. Can you help me? .

SARGE: Yeah, we've got it! Definitely! We'll definitely help you out.

SLIDE 58 - SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE - AQUAKINESIS TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Hold on guys, it's another Superpower Challenge! It's aquakinesis. We need somebody who can move water with just their mind. Who thinks they can help out?

SARGE selects a new child from the audience and guides them onto the stage.

SARGE: Give him/her a hand, everybody! Awesome! Come on down! What's your name?

CHILD: Answers with his/her name.

SARGE: Come right over here (child's name). Good! All right, (child's name), stand right here.

SARGE guides the child to stage left of the screen and gets the can ready to hand to the child.

SARGE: Turn around this way. You're going to hold this up. This is the exact same can that he has! Hold it up like this!

SARGE helps the child hold the can out in front of them with both hands.

SARGE: Now, I'm going to get some water here. We're going to give it to him. Hold it up high. Keep it steady.

During the next speech, SARGE is pouring water into the can as the child holds it.

SARGE: We're going to give him the water, and we're going to send it to him, but you guys are going to have to focus. Okay, in goes the water. You guys are going to have to focus and concentrate when we do this. It's going to take everybody in the room. All right, are you guys ready?

AUDIENCE: Yes!

SARGE: All right, here we go. Put your hand on top.

SARGE is guiding the child who is on stage.

SARGE: Let me hear you say: We can do it!

CHILD and AUDIENCE: We can do it!

SARGE: Say: You can do it!

AUDIENCE: You can do it!

SARGE: I can do it!

AUDIENCE: I can do it!

SARGE takes the can from the child and looks inside in amazement. SARGE then tips the can over, showing that it is now empty.

SARGE: Guys it's gone! Give him/her a big hand.

[Applause]

SARGE: Good job! Have a seat.

SARGE guides the child off the stage and back to his/her seat.

SARGE: Have a seat. There you go, awesome! All right guys, we've got to move. Let's see what's next.

SLIDE 59 - SUPER POWER CHALLENGE - X-RAY VISION TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Oh, wait, guys... It's another superpower challenge! I know this one's going to be x-ray vision! Who can help me out? Who's got this? Let's see...

SARGE chooses a new child from the audience.

SARGE: Come on down! Give him/her a hand, everybody.

[APPLAUSE]

What's your name?

CHILD: Says their name

SARGE: Give him/her another big hand.

[Applause]

SARGE leads the child to the stage left of the screen.

SARGE: Come on, let's do this. Here we go! Glasses on! All right, you've got to focus.

SLIDE 60 - X-RAY VISION - VOLUNTEER

SARGE: Focus up on the big screen. What does it say? Do you see it? Can you see it?

CHILD: Don't gossip.

SARGE: Tell everybody what it says, tell them.

CHILD: Don't gossip!

SARGE: Let me hear you say it!

CHILD and AUDIENCE: Don't gossip!

SARGE: Give him/her a big round of applause!

[Applause]

SARGE guides the child off the stage, ensuring they return to his/her seat.

SARGE: Guys, let's do the reveal! Look, concentrate!

SLIDE 61 - X-RAY VISION REVEAL- DON'T GOSSIP

SARGE: Don't gossip! That's right. Now, raise your hand if you know what gossip means. Do you guys know? I'll tell you. Gossip means talking about someone or something that has happened repeatedly to spread the word around. Don't do it, because the bully wants to be famous, and you're only helping them. You're making them famous. Don't do it! Don't talk about it amongst yourselves. If you're going to talk about it, go tell a grown-up. What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Tell a grownup!

SARGE: But don't talk... don't gossip! Don't put it on the internet. Don't run and tell each other, just keep it quiet, and tell a grown-up. Good! That takes the power away from the bully.

They just want to be famous. Don't give them that power! No! All right... Let's see what we've got next...

SLIDE 62 - MAP IMAGE

SARGE: Now, let's see, the bullies are in the Canyon Lands, and Billy is in the Whispering Forest of Doubt. Everybody say Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

SARGE: Can you hear me, Billy?

Video of Billy in the forest begins.

SLIDE 63 - BILLY MEETS CRYBOT

While a video of Billy interacting with Crybot plays, SARGE pantomimes trying to reach Billy through the headset.

BILLY: Is anyone there? Hello?

CRYBOT: I c-c-c-can't do it. I just can't.

(Crybot the Robot is sniffling and crying.)

BILLY: You can do it! I know you can.

CRYBOT: But every time I stand up and move those awful voices start up again. I freeze. My arms won't move. My legs won't move. And I start to cry! Deep crying.

BILLY: There not real. You gotta believe me. Look what's your name?

CRYBOT: C-C-C-Crybot.

BILLY: Crybot? Why are you called "Crybot"

CRYBOT: Everyone just calls me that because I am so sensitive. I was an experimental robot. My makers were trying to add human feelings to robots, but the experiment failed. I am the last Crybot. We were perceived as weak because we feel things so deeply.

BILLY: Look feeling things deeply is not always a weakness. You have to learn to control things better though. You can do this.

CRYBOT: B-b-but I can't.

BILLY: Yes, you can!

CRYBOT: But how?

BILLY: We just learned to use our minds. I am trying to .. Oh no! I forgot about the Bullies. We have to do this now! These Bullies are coming to get me. Listen you can do this. I'll help you.

CRYBOT: Who is we?

BILLY: What?

CRYBOT: Who is we? You said we.

BILLY: Oh I have some friends. I can only see them sometimes. They are usually over..

(Billy talks to the video screen.)

BILLY: Guys are you there?

SARGE: You can't hear us... you can't hear us. But guys, He's got a friend! That's awesome! Friends are very powerful. Friends are everyones superpower.

SLIDE 64 - TITLE GOOD CHOICE BAD CHOICE

SARGE: Oh... it looks like it's time for Good Choice, Bad Choice! Let's see what our choices are...

SLIDE 65 - YOU SHOULD... PAGE

SARGE: Huh... What do you do again, if someone is calling you names or making fun of you? What do you do? Tell them to stop! What do you tell them?

AUDIENCE: Tell them to stop!

SARGE: Walk away!

AUDIENCE: Walk away!

SARGE: Ignore them!

AUDIENCE: Ignore them!

SARGE: Tell a grownup!

AUDIENCE: Tell a grown-up!

SARGE: Good job, guys! All right, all right... let's check in

here. Hold on. Billy, are you there? Billy?

Video of bullies starts to play.

SLIDE 66 - BULLIES STRUGGLING

BULLY: Give it back!

SARGE: Good, that slows them down! That's good! Let's try Billy

again. Everybody say Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

Video of Crybot and Billy plays.

SLIDE 67 - CRYBOT THE SOUND IS GONE - SHOOTING DOWN WORDS

CRYBOT: The sound is gone but the words are still here!

BILLY: It's Ok Crybot! They can't hurt you. I think they are always there. You can now control them and make them disappear.

CRYBOT: I know what to do! My vision is sharper. I can feel my power returning. I can use my lasers.

(Crybot's eyes start to glow and they shoot out red lasers that start to destroy the comic book words written around them.)

CRYBOT: I can use my lasers.

SARGE: Oh look, he's blocking them out! Guys, you've got to learn to do this! Block them out! Forget them! They don't mean anything! Don't listen to what people say. No! Don't give them

the power. Good job, give them a hand, everybody, that was really awesome.

[Applause]

SARGE: All right, hold on... What's that?

SLIDE 68 - PHYSICAL TRAINING TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Oh, physical training! One more time! Go, go, get up! Let's go! We're going fast, super fast! Ready? 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 1 2 3 4 5 6 78 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8.

SARGE is leading them through the dance moves.

SARGE: Sit down you guys! You got it! Give yourself a hand!

[Applause]

SARGE: All right, good. Let's see... what's up here. Billy?

SLIDE 69 - CRYBOT SAYS GOODBYE

CRYBOT: Billy, I cant go that way.

BILLY: What? Why?

CRYBOT: I have to return to my family. They are back this way in the d-d-d-desert.

BILLY: Ok, I hate to see you go.

CRYBOT: Thank you, B-Billy. Maybe we will meet again. I will miss you!

SARGE: Oh, he's losing his friend! Say bye Crybot!

AUDIENCE: Bye, Crybot!

SARGE: It's okay, we'll still be Billy's friends. We can help him! Gosh, friends are so important!

SLIDE 70 - SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE - X-RAY VISION TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Look! It's another Superpower Challenge! I know what it's going to be... x-ray vision!

SARGE picks a new child from the audience and calls them up onto the stage.

SARGE: Give him/her a hand!

[Applause]

SARGE: What's your name?

CHILD: Says their name

SARGE: That's awesome! Okay, come over here.

SARGE quides the child to the stage left of the screen.

SARGE: Let's get your glasses on. Everybody's got to focus. Help him/her out.

SLIDE 71 - X-RAY VISION - VOLUNTEER

SARGE: Look how cool! Look right over here. (at the screen)

Focus. Do you see what it says? Shout it out.

CHILD: Make friends!

SARGE: Great Job! Let's turn around and do a reveal!

SLIDE 72 - X-RAY VISION REVEAL - MAKE FRIENDS!

SARGE: Make friends! Give him/her a hand!

SARGE guides the child off the stage and ensures they return to their seat.

Give another big hand, everybody!

[Applause]

SARGE: Great job, guys! This is so important- listen! Make friends! Friends are your superpower. They help you when you're in trouble. They can go get a grown-up. They can listen to your story. If you see someone being bullied, make friends with them!

Get them to a grown-up! Try to help them! Listen to their story. Make friends! It's your superpower! That's right! All right... Let's see what's next... Let's see where we are here...

SLIDE 73 - MAP IMAGE

The bullies are in the forest! Billy is at the Castle Gate Bridge. Everybody say Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

SARGE: Billy, are you there?

SLIDE 74- BILLY AT CASTLE GATE

Video of Billy plays.

BILLY: I can't open it. Can you guys help me?

SARGE: We've got you! We can help you! We've got this!

SLIDE 75 - SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE - TELEKINESIS TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Guys, it's time for another Superpower Challenge! It's time for telekinesis! I need someone who has the ability to move objects with their mind... Hold on... let's see... who's it going to be?

SARGE chooses a new child from the audience and guides them onto the stage.

SARGE: What's your name?

CHILD: Says their name

SARGE: Give it up for (child's name), everybody!

[Applause]

SARGE: All right, I'm so glad you're here with me. Now listen, listen carefully.

SARGE takes out the lock and directs the kid while speaking.

SARGE: Put your hand on this lock. Okay, now try to pull it open! Pull as hard as you can! Pull, pull, pull!

The child fails to pull the lock open.

SARGE: Give him/her a hand for trying!

[Applause]

Sarge has the child stay on the stage, while going down to the audience and having someone in the front try to open the lock.

SARGE: Let's see... we need someone who's been working out. Who's been working out? Who's got this? I don't work out, not me... Try to open this... see if you can pull it open... pull... Okay, enough, you can stop. Give him/her a hand for trying!

[Applause]

SARGE: It's okay! I think we can do this just with the mind. I don't think it takes strength at all! Telekinesis is about the mind. Here we go...

SARGE crosses to the original child and has them help.

SARGE: Put your finger right here. Here we go. Let me hear you say: you can do it!

AUDIENCE: You can do it!

SARGE: You can do it!

AUDIENCE: You can do it!

SARGE: I can do it!

CHILD and AUDIENCE: I can do it!

SARGE makes the lock open up for the kid creating the illusion that they did it.

SARGE: He/she did it! Give him/her a hand!

[Applause]

SARGE: Good job!

Sarge guides the child off the stage seeing they make it back to their seat.

SARGE: Give another big round of applause everyone!

[Applause]

SARGE: What a great job! Alright, cool..alright, let's see... let's check in. Let's see what's going on.

SLIDE 76 - MAP IMAGE

SARGE: All right, the bullies are on the Castle Gate Bridge, and Billy has already run into the castle. Let's see if we can reach him. Everybody say Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

SARGE: Okay, Billy... Billy... are you there? Billy!

SLIDE 77 - BILLY IN THE CASTLE - SPEAKS TO EM

Video of Billy in the castle plays.

SARGE: Wait shh.. he's in!

BILLY: Are you here? Anyone? Somebody?

SARGE: Somebody's there!

OMINOUS VOICE: Say..who dares enter my castle?

BILLY: I do! My name is Billy.

OMINOUS VOICE: And what is it you want Billy?

BILLY: All I want is to go home! That's all I want!

OMINOUS VOICE: There's only one way home and it's through that mirror.

SARGE: You've got this! You can do it! Billy... he can't hear us...

SLIDE 78 - BULLIES AT CASTLE GATE

Video plays of bullies

KAT: Wow! It looks beautiful!

THUGEE: Talk about ancient knights and armor.

CLAY: Yeah kinda. The kids probably went that way so let's go.

KAT: No, I can't. I'm afraid of heights.

CLAY: I got your back. Come on.

KAT: I don't know...

CLAY: Come on!

SARGE: Oh good, good they're slowing down...Let's try Billy again.

Everybody say Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

SARGE: I don't think he can hear us... Billy?

SLIDE 79 - SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE - X-RAY VISION TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Oh wait a minute... It's a Superpower Challenge! Guys let's see what this is. I think it's x-ray vision! Who can help me out? Who can do this?

SARGE selects a new child from the audience and sees that they come onto the stage.

SARGE: Here we go! Come on down. What's your name?

CHILD: Says their name

SARGE: Repeats their name. Nice, here we go.

SARGE leads the child stage left of the screen and puts the glasses on him/her.

SLIDE 80 - X-RAY VISION - VOLUNTEER

SARGE: Give him/her your hands!

[Applause]

SARGE: All right, listen. What does it say? Shout it out and tell everybody!

CHILD: Tell a grown up!

SARGE: Tell a grownup! Let's see...hold on ...

SLIDE 81 - X-RAY VISION REVEAL - TELL A GROWN UP

SARGE: Do you see it? Tell a grownup! Give him/her your hands everybody!

[Applause]

SARGE sees that the child makes it off of the stage safely.

SARGE: Please have a seat... be careful. Good. Guys, this is the number one most important thing to do! Tell a grownup! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Tell a grownup!

SARGE: If you see someone being bullied, tell a grownup. If you're being bullied, tell a grownup. Get some help. It's the fastest way to end the problem. All right, good. Let's see what's next, guys. Let's see… hold on. Billy, Billy... come in.

SLIDE 82 - BILLY JUMPS THROUGH THE MIRROR

Video of Billy in the castle plays.

BILLY: It's solid glass. How do I?

OMINOUS VOICE: You know the answer my boy or you wouldn't have made it this far.

BILLY: But I don't!

OMINOUS VOICE: It's a leap of faith. You must trust in yourself. Yes, as you've done before.

SARGE: Come on... come on...

BILLY: A leap of faith! I can jump into it... Oh man ...

The bullies enter the castle.

CLAY: Hey, there you are Piggy. We're going to get you now.

THUGGE: Yeah, you're going to tell us how to get home.

KAT: Yeah, after we're done with you!

BILLY: You probably don't have what it takes to get home! You'll be stuck here forever!

Billy jumps into the portal.

SARGE: Oh there he goes! He's gone guys! Give him a hand!

[Applause]

SARGE: He's on his way back! He did it! He did it!

SARGE: listens into the headset.

SARGE: Hold on... hold on... he's not back yet. What? Hold on... he's not back yet. There's a problem... Just a second... Billy... hold on... oh, they want us to go to a Superpower Challenge for right now!

SLIDE 83 - SUPERPOWER CHALLENGE - SUPERHUMAN STRENGTH TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Let's see... I know what we'll do!

SARGE crosses to Thor's hammer.

SARGE: Who did it first? Who is the first person who tried to do this? Come on down here!

The first child who came up comes to the stage to try again.

SARGE: Yeah, come on down. Do you think you can do it this time? Do you think you can do it? Come on over here.

SARGE leads the child to the hammer and gets them into proper positioning.

SARGE: Let's see if you can do this! All right! Let me hear you

say: I am worthy

CHILD: I am worthy!

SARGE: has the child pick up the hammer.

SARGE: He/she did it! Good job! Put it down. Awesome! Give

him/her another big round of applause!

[Applause]

SARGE sees that the child makes it off of the stage and back to his/her seat.

SARGE: Awesome job! That's awesome guys! You've done a fantastic

job today! Oh, let's check on Billy. Everybody say Billy!

AUDIENCE: Billy!

SARGE: Billy, come in. Hold on. Billy, hold on. Billy...

SLIDE 84 -BILLY'S GOODBYE

SARGE: Oh he's back! He's back!

Video plays of Billy's goodbye.

BILLY: Hey guys, I'm in level three. Thanks a lot. Good luck in

your training!

SARGE: Awesome, we did it! Give him a hand!

[Applause]

SARGE: He's back again! Wow! Well, we've got only a few things

left to do.

SLIDE 85 - REVIEW - STAY AWAY

SARGE: It's time to review. Everybody say stay away!

AUDIENCE: Stay away!

SARGE: Stay away! That's right! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Stay away!

SARGE: Don't give the bully a chance! Just stay away from them.

That's right! Let's see what this one is...

SLIDE 86 -REVIEW - MAKE FRIENDS

Make friends! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Make friends!

SARGE: That's your superpower! Make friends! Work together! If you can help someone beat a bully, talk to them. Get them to a grown-up. If you need help, talk to people. Get some friends! Good, all right...

SLIDE 87 - REVIEW - DON'T GOSSIP

And don't gossip! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Don't gossip!

SARGE: Don't make a bully famous. Just keep it to yourself. But

what should you do ...?

SLIDE 88 - REVIEW - TELL A GROWNUP

Tell a grownup! What did I say?

AUDIENCE: Tell a grownup!

SARGE: Well, there's only one last thing to say here that I like

to keep in mind.

SLIDE 89 - BE KIND ALL THE TIME

SARGE: It is: Be kind all the time! Say it with me!

SARGE and AUDIENCE: Be kind all the time!

SARGE: Awesome guys! Let's celebrate!

SLIDE 90 - PHYSICAL TRAINING TITLE PAGE

Music begins.

SARGE: It's time for our physical training! Get up everybody! Let's move! I'm going to come down to you, but let's practice a little. Come on guys.

SARGE walks them through a dance.

SARGE: Side to side, side to side. Here we go...side to side. There you go! Side to side. Good! You're going to keep moving! Very good. Now we're going to keep that groove, and we're going to add on! All right, let's jump up and down! There you go! Jump up and down! There you go! Put your hands up! Now down low, down low. Let's go side to side! Come on! Side to side, side to side.

Then SARGE leads them through Super Me poses with a countdown like before.

1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7,8 x 5

SARGE: Repeat: I am super me, you are super you!

AUDIENCE: I am super me, you are super you!

SARGE: Repeat: I am super me, you are super too!

AUDIENCE: I am super me, you are super too!

SARGE: Good job guys! Congratulations! You've entered into level two of the Super Me Training Program! Give yourselves a big hand everybody!

[Applause]

SARGE: Great job boys and girls! I want to thank you! You've been a fantastic audience today, and I want to invite you to visit us online at The Story Ship!

SLIDE 91 - SUPER ME TITLE PAGE

SARGE: Just look up Super Me! You'll find lots of wonderful videos online. There's also other subject areas like science and math. All of it is at thestoryship.com. We are all over social media, guys! Give yourselves all a round of applause!

[Applause]

In this speech, SARGE can find time to thank whoever/whatever group sponsored the show/who hosted it, the parents, etc.

SARGE: Thank you for letting me do what I love to do! Before we go, I need everyone to close your eyes. Silence. Okay, I need a big breath in through your nose and blow out. A big breath in, and blow out. A big breath in, and blow out. Open your eyes, look at your teachers or grownups and say: we love you!

If SARGE is at a school or organized function with groups, SARGE can direct the kids to listen to their teachers/grownups and get ready to be directed out of the space.
