## NOTICE OF RACE

### 0 A CLEAN REGATTA

- 0.1 While this event is not officially registered as a Clean Regatta through Sailors for the Seas, WRSC is committed to upholding the core principles of environmental responsibility set forth by the organization. A water bottle filling station is available onsite, and we strongly encourage all participants to bring reusable bottles and join us in practicing a clean, sustainable regatta.

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, together with the rules of the participating classes, the sailing instructions, and any additional sailing instructions to be issued at the competitors' meeting.

### 2 COMMUNICATION

- 2.1 It is strongly suggested that all boats carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on all standard channels including but not limited to Channel 5.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Albacore, A-Class, Open Cat, Flying Scot, Chesapeake 20, and Wayfarer.
- 3.2 Boats may enter the regatta by registering online at [westriversc.com/odweekend](https://westriversc.com/odweekend)
- 3.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 3.4 A minimum of three(3) boats must be registered two(2) weeks prior, August 16, 2025, to the event in order to guarantee a start for that fleet.



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## 3.5 CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- a** To qualify for the Wayfarer North American Championship or the Flying Scot Atlantic Coast Championship, participants must be members of the respective national class organizations.
- b** WRSC members are exempt from this membership requirement and are welcome to participate in the events. However, they will not be eligible for championship trophies unless they hold national class membership.

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## 5.2 NUMBER OF RACES

There is no limit to the number of races. The committee will attempt to maximize racing for the conditions available.

## 6 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

5.1 All support boat vessels shall check-in/register during the check-in process on the first day of the event.

## 6 LAUNCHING + LOCATION + TRAILER PARKING

6.1 WRSC has both crane and beach launch available. Please note no vehicles are permitted on the beach ramp.

6.2 WRSC is located at 4800 Riverside Drive, Galesville, MD 20765.

6.3 Please park trailers on the additional lot adjacent to the club, which can be accessed via the corner on East Benning. This is also an additional parking lot for the event.

## 7 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

7.1 A chartered or loaned boat may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules.

## 8 PRIZES

8.1 For each class, prizes will be given to the first-place finisher in classes with three or fewer entries, the first two finishers in classes with five or fewer entries, and the first three finishers in classes with seven or more entries.

8.2 The Billy Heintz Memorial perpetual trophy will be awarded to first place finisher in the class with the largest number of registered competitors

## 9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.



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## 10 FOOD AND BEVERAGES

- 10.1 The bar will be open post A2G on Friday, Saturday night, and post race and awards ceremony on Sunday. Friday night dinner is available for purchase on a first come first serve basis. Chef Shay will be serving dinner on the Saturday of the event. Dinner is included for race participants in the race fees. Additional dinner tickets can be bought on the regatta network website for an additional \$30/pp prior to August 27, 2025 at 1200hrs EST.
