

EXERCISE TEST VERIFICATION FEEDBACK AND RECOMMENDATIONS

On March 30 and 31, we conducted practice tests of joint experiments of four schools (and three schools) in Tallinn. **Based on the check up of verifications, we identified the main errors in the identification of the person, in which case it is not possible to perform successful identification and the results of the tests are not taken into account.**

NB! Verification and test results will only be considered if performed on a DESKTOP or LAPTOP. Verifications and tests performed on smartphones, mobile phones, etc. are not taken into account.

1) false document - a person cannot be identified with a student ticket or driving license, in order to identify a person, the candidate's ID card or passport is required, of which the students have been notified in advance and which are also provided in the admission procedures;

2) instead of the document, an image made of the document was used, which was shown on the telephone or in print - such verifications are not taken into account;

3) the verification was performed by the wrong person or other people were in the frame when the person was identified or intensively communicated with someone else during the identification - only the person whose identity is being identified must be in the frame when the person is identified; we also expect correct behavior and a polite attitude in the identification process; the tests must also be carried out independently, without recourse to outside assistance;

4) the document was shown too far or at an angle or the information on the document was hidden by hand - place the document close enough to the camera (the screen displays a frame for both the document and the candidate's face - hold it) and do not hold the document tilted (skewed);

5) the person was identified in too dark a room or there was a window behind the person's back (or on the diagonal side), so the image of the document or candidate was not of suitable quality, the data could not be read from the document - make sure there is enough light in the room and do not sit all; (if the window is directly behind the camera, the document may be mirrored and it will also become unreadable);

6) Images are blurred - Hold the document (long enough) during verification and follow the instructions above using a camera of the appropriate quality.

Please follow the tips above to pass the successful verification on April 9, which is a prerequisite for taking the test results into account.

What to do if verification gets stuck?

If the page stays loading, do not refresh immediately or close the window for the first 5-10 seconds. Have some patience. If the system remains "reloading" the next page for a minute or more during person detection, refresh the page or cancel the verification session and run it again. There is a reasonable time buffer for verification, so please be patient.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Can I do personal identification or e-tests on an iPad or smart device (such as a phone)?
NO.

2. Can a student card or Smart-ID be used for verification instead of an ID card or passport?

NO. A distinction must be made between EIS login and verification.

EIS can be logged in using an ID card or Har-ID or Smart-ID, etc., listed above in this document.

Verification determines if the tests are solved by the student who registered for the tests. To do this, you need an identity document with a picture - a passport or ID card.

3. I have registered for joint tests, but I do not see that I have been directed to enter the EIS.

Make sure that you have not logged in to the EIS with a test password you have used before, this only solved one test.

4. Do I need an ID card reader?

An ID card reader is not required for verification. If you use an ID card when logging in to the EIS environment, you need an ID card reader.

5. When solving the test, is it possible to skip some questions at the beginning and then return to them later?

No. The tests are one-way, which means that you cannot go back to previous tasks.

6. Does personal identification have to be performed before each substance test?

No. Identification is carried out at a specific time before the start of the test.

7. Can I close my browser during tests or between test sections?

No. In this case, you will need to re-verify.

8. Can I identify a person on one device and perform tests on another device?

No, identification and testing must be on the same device. Otherwise, the results of the tests will not be taken into account when applying.

9. Can I take the basic tests if I have not passed the practice test?

Yes, but participating in an exercise test is strongly recommended to practice using the systems.

10. If I cannot take the tests on April 9 for good reason, can I take post-tests?

No. Unfortunately, no follow-up tests will be held this academic year.

11. Can I leave an e-test for a subject unresolved if the school or field of study I am applying for does not take the result into account?

Yes. Before doing so, we definitely recommend making sure that the solution of the e-test of the respective subject is not taken into account at the admission. Information on which test results schools take into account and what weight is included in each school's admissions procedure.

12. Do the ratings on the grade sheet have weight in the decision to invite you for an interview?
Yes. When inviting to an interview, in addition to the results of the e-tests, the information reflected in the grade sheet of the participant in the joint tests is also taken into account.

13. Do I have to take e-tests if I have been exempted from taking written tests due to my participation in the final round of the Subject Olympiad?
No, students who are exempted from the tests do not take the tests.

14. What should I do if I close my browser while taking the test?
You need to log in to EIS again and click the "Continue" button. Re-identification is required to proceed. The test opens from a task in progress.

15. What should I do if I have not completed the test but cannot continue?
Refresh the page (Refresh or Reload page or Ctrl + R or F5)
Close the browser for a while, open it again, log in to EIS and prove your identity. The test opens from a task in progress.

16. Can I take test questions or take screenshots (screenshots) while taking the test?
No.

17. What to do if it is not possible to immediately insert a punctuation mark in the sentence in the Estonian language task?

REMINDER ABOUT GRADE SHEETS

All candidates must send their grade sheet for the entire current academic year to the schools to which they are applying by **9 April** at the latest via an information system message.

Guide for Studio Users.

- Open the "By subjects" view from the "Lessons, grades" tab of your overview,
- Start printing the page (File -> Print or right-click on the page and "Print"),
- Select "Save as PDF" or another similar option as the printer (the specific name depends on the browser used),
- Add a name to the file in the form: LastName_FirstName,
- Click "Save".

Guide for eSchool users.

- Open the eSchool grade sheet,
- In the "Show" options, add "Explanation" (rating scales) and "Missing hours",
- Select "year" for the period
- Right-click and select "Print",
- Select "Save as pdf" from the drop-down menu

- Add a name to the file in the form: LastName_FirstName,
- Click "Save".
