

SHILOH MUSIC

Shiloh Christian Academy is offering an extracurricular music class on Thursdays after school from 3:30-5:30pm. The music program is targeted toward 6th to 12th graders but some younger students are admitted in the program after audition. All students need to audition the first year to sign up for the program. Auditions will be held the week before school starts.

Shiloh Music is directed by Mariane Wottrich and presents a choir concert in December and a staged musical theater production in the spring. The goal of this class is to help students grow in their musical and theater skills, to lead them to seek excellence, and to equip them to live out the Gospel of Jesus Christ through performing arts.

TUITION

Students registered in the core program at Shiloh Christian Academy will pay a music fee of \$25/month per class (\$250 for the year). Extracurricular students will pay \$60/month in tuition (\$600 for the year), in addition to the registration fee (\$100 before June 1st and \$200 after that).

What's included:

- 2 hours of instruction per week
- Assignments at home during the week
- 34 weeks of instruction between August 21 and May 21.
- Choir performance at about 15 chapel times throughout the school year
- Free attendance to weekly Chapel and Bible class Mondays/Thursdays 9-10am
- The music class can count for high school credits
