Dear Parent/Guardian,

We understand that you likely have many questions about your child's attendance and schoolwork during the quarantine period. This letter will provide you with the information you and your child will need during the quarantine period.

Your Child's Attendance during quarantine

According to state regulation, students may be counted as *present* during the quarantine period as *NOTE: Students on quarantine can not participate in any school events, extra-curricular, or athletic teams. This includes attendance at games or after school functions.*

Quarantine Student Expectations

Students have the choice to work synchronously (JCPS District Resource Teacher) or asynchronously (School-Based Learning) with support via google meets/classroom. You may contact Ashley Poore <u>ashley.poore@jefferson.kyschools.us</u> if you have questions about quarantine expectations.

Asynchronous Support (School-Based Learning)

- If a student selects to work asynchronously (School-based learning), the student will complete the work posted in Google Classroom by their Central teachers.
- If a student needs additional support with their assignments, Central High School teachers will be available via Google Meet to provide support/help from 2:30-4:00pm. Students can log in any time between 2:30-4:00. Please see schedule below.

*students will receive alternative assignments for magnet programming upon return to school. Synchronous Learning (District Support)

When a student is marked as quarantined, your child will automatically receive an invitation from the district classroom. *Please be advised that there is often a delay in receiving this invitation*. *Central High School staff does not have control of or access to district classrooms*.

- Quarantined students are <u>required</u> to accept the Google Classroom invitation <u>AND</u> check-in for synchronous (District Resource Teacher) support daily when quarantined.
- Note: Students may not receive an email if they have turned off Google Classroom Notifications. In this case, students will go to <u>classroom.google.com</u> and on the top row they will see their assigned JCPS Google Classroom with a blue join button.

- Students MUST check-in daily. IF they do not need support, they will state they do not need support and log out.
- District sessions are offered Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at both 9-10 a.m. and 12-1 p.m.

Student Services and Enrichment:

There will be a combination of both synchronous(district) and asynchronous (school-based) lessons focused on the grade level standards to support students.

• For ECE, the caseload manager must implement the IEP to the fullest extent possible.

Students who Choose not to Participate in Learning during Quarantine

Students who choose not to participate in learning or do not receive the equivalent of six hours of instruction will be marked as either *absent excused* or *absent unexcused*.

***Please note:JCPS has implemented an optional program called Test to Stay for students who are a close contact of someone with COVID-19. Students participating in Test to Stay have the option not to quarantine. To qualify, they have to take a COVID-19 test every night for seven days.
