SUPPLY LIST

2025 – 2026 school year

Below are optimal classroom supplies that you may choose to purchase to help support student learning. The items on this list will be used during the regular school day. They may be brought from home on a voluntary basis. Otherwise, they will be furnished by the school

Organization is an important skill for 6th graders to practice. When students enter middle school and have multiple teachers, they must be organized! Therefore, in 6th grade, students will be using an accordion file folder along with agendas, composition books, and other supplies.

Individual Items

- Accordion file folder with 7 or more tabs and pockets. Accordion file folder needs to be no more than 10¹/₂ inches wide to fit in a cubby tub.
- 4 bound composition books (not spirals)
- A basic calculator (it does not need to be scientific)
- Ruler with ***both*** inches & centimeters (no bendable rulers)
- Headphones (over ears)
- Highlighters
- Pencils
- Colored pencils
- Scissors
- Glue (liquid glue works best)
- A package of lined paper (college ruled)
- Mouse for Chromebook
- Sharpies and/or other markers (optional)
- Pencil bag for supplies
- Thin expo markers

- **1- 1" 3 ring binder**

Shared Items

- Dry-erase markers (optional)
- 2 Packages of cleaning wipes (Disinfectant, Lysol, etc.)
- 1 box of quart or gallon Ziploc bags

- 1 paper towel roll (Last names M-Z)
