#### By Bus

#### By Rall

The nearest station to Southend Hospital is Prittlewell on the National Express Eastern line from London Liverpool Street to Southend Victoria. Prittlewell station is approximately 20 minutes' walk from the hospital and can be reached on foot or by taxi. If using the c2c London Fenchurch Street line, the nearest station is Westcliff on Sea. Check the relevant train line and bus websites for the most up to date information on public transport.



#### By Car A13

Follow the A13 from either London or Southend direction until the traffic lights at Chalkwell Park. Turn onto Southbourne Grove (A1158) signposted 'Hospital'. Turn right at the second set of traffic lights onto Prittlewell Chase. Continue along Prittlewell Chase, the hospital is located on the left hand side of the dual carriageway.
