

Okay so I know there's 7 steps in here, but it's really just a bunch of copying and pasting. No worries!

(Canvas size is 1916 x 2676)

1. Copy the "Card Canvas" image and paste it into one layer.
2. Create a new layer (this is where your drawing will be.)
3. Choose one of the Template images, depending on the color you prefer, and copy and paste it onto another layer.
4. Once this is all done, you'll just need to grab a cost icon, attribute icon, power number, and "counter" number, which you can all find in their respective folders. (The counter images are just in the main folder) Copy and paste them into different layers, and wallah, the card template has been assembled!
5. For names, you can either type them in yourself or you could ask me to do it as well (it's better if you ping in the server since I don't notice DMs as quickly.) If you want to type in the character names yourself, the font used is Roboto (Medium) which you can officially get from Google Fonts. The font sizes are shown in the Sample Card images.
6. There's also a section on the right that displays the artist's name. If you choose to not have white borders on your card, place a 2 px-wide outline around your name if you want to type it in yourself. You could also ask me if you want me to put it in for you.
7. Outside of that though, you're pretty much good to go! Just pick an OP character and draw 'em behind the template layer, and wallah, you've created your own OP TCG card.
