

Year 7 Music | Ukulele

Key Question: How do Taylor Swift and Ed Sheeran accompany themselves when singing their songs?

Topic Overview: This term students will learn how to identify and play ukulele chords. They will experience rehearsing chord sequences and singing a variety of popular songs. Students will be given the opportunity to perform as soloists, in small groups and as part of a whole class ensemble.

Week 3: Lesson 1	How do I play the G chord?	Students will experience whole class ukulele playing through learning the song "shake it off" by Tayler Swift		
Week 4: Lesson 1	How do I practise effectively?	Students will practise 'Shake it off' by Taylor Swift.		
Week 5: Lesson 1	Assessment Week	Students will perform the song "Shake it off" on their ukuleles transitioning between chords as fluently as possible.		
Week 6: Lesson 1	Try Now	Students will learn one further chord of D minor and will try learning the chord accompaniment to the rock anthem "eye of the tiger".
