Cell Phone (PED) Policy

- Cell phones shall not be **accessible, visible, or in use** at any time while inside the classroom or hallways, during the instructional day.
- Cell phones may be used during a student's assigned lunch for educational purposes.
- Cell phones are not to be accessed during restroom breaks per Restroom Policy.

MHS Consequences For Accessing Cell Phone/Device In Class Without Permission:

Offense	Teacher Procedure	Administrator Consequence
1st Offense with Student Using Cell Phone/Device At Inappropriate Time	Call for student removal and write a discipline referral	• School level detention. Block or Period of ISS
2nd Offense with Student Using Cell Phone/Device At Inappropriate Time	Call for student removal and write a discipline referral	• ISS
3rd Offense with Student Using Cell Phone/Device At Inappropriate Time	Call for student removal and write a discipline referral	• OSS

District Cell Phone Policy

For high schools, personal electronic devices cannot be used by students in classrooms or hallways during the instructional day (8:45am - 3:45pm). All personal devices must remain out of sight of others and be silenced during this time. Students, however, may use personal electronic devices during lunch for educational purposes only.
