

Cell Phone (PED) Policy

- Cell phones shall not be <u>accessible</u>, <u>visible</u>, <u>or in use</u> at any time while inside the classroom or hallways, during the instructional day.
- Cell phones may be used during a student's assigned lunch for educational purposes.
- Cell phones are not to be accessed during restroom breaks per Restroom Policy.

District Cell Phone Policy

For high schools, personal electronic devices cannot be used by students in classrooms or hallways during the instructional day (8:45am - 3:45pm).
