State Recap: Franke noted that hopefully we will be back to normal next year, noting that some of the meets were not full. Perhaps look at some of the time standards (will put together a committee to do that) to aim for 6-9 heats total in prelims per event, staying the same for at least four years and to keep the meet at a championship meet size. He was amazed that numbers wise, we were at 75 percent participation and that was without relay alternates.

Kristina Nesbitt had the idea of having each classification meet as a timed final and then the top 30 moving on to a SUPER STATE final meet, almost like divisionals and then ALL-STATE as a finale. It would honor both small and large teams. The challenge is the number of days in the facility. All seemed to like that idea. Some asked about doing the divisional part at other pools or even using split pools at Tech is another idea.

Other Feedback: The start date of Oct. (before Halloween) was earlier this year and most were happy about that.

Proposal was brought to the floor to tie the two double winners in the 7A girls for swimmer of the year award. That passed, so Abigail McCulloch and Lily Burke won.
