 - rubrics already distributed: what to work on
 - They will send out a summary of the data, where gaps are and support needed.
 - Continue the workshop (December/January) as it was helpful before.
 - Murray sent potential changes that were coming - needs to be done within local control and your school board.
 - Maybe potential changes to the template, but not probably large-scale changes.
 - The committee for Region 13 needs to convene and distribute the information to the schools.
 - DE is more so looking for narratives, more detailed experience rather than bullet points
 - The scores might not be great due to the new template. - Make sure to focus on growth and not just jumping up to the highest point on the rubric.

 - Teachers didn't find value
 - MOValley-use in dual enrollment classes.
 - What certifications are kids getting

- Do businesses value certifications?
 - If it is important, how can we promote it?
- LC: architecture; doesn't have direction from state so uses precision standards so they are aligned.
- Businesses-if students are coming in with certifications-make note of that
 - get that minor or certification
 - certifications can expire
- Do businesses know what certifications are?
 - get into businesses and let them know
- YouScience-list of businesses that align now? The website tells the exam name, but does not tell me the credential they will be earning. Industry RECOGNIZED?
- Credential pathways-Are there other companies that offer certifications?
- Woodbine-creates curriculum that aligns with industry needs. businesses don't know what the certifications are-don't care.
