## How to Link to a Page

(Text Field)

With the new update, users can add links to any page on any text field with a couple of clicks. This is fairly straightforward, but I've outlined the steps below.



- 1. Navigate to the page you wish to edit and click the **Edit** button. (*It can be found underneath the page header on the right and looks like a pencil*.)
- 2. Go to the text field where you wish to add a link.
- 3. A row of **Add Link** buttons should appear along the bottom of the text field. Click the one that corresponds to the type of page you wish to link to see a dropdown list.
- 4. Select the page you wish to link to. A link code will appear in the text field.
- 5. Save your changes by clicking on the **Save** button. (*It can be found underneath the page header on the right and looks like a floppy disk.*)
- 6. Your link will now be visible.

## Instructions with Screenshots

1. Navigate to the page you wish to edit and click the **Edit** button. (*It can be found underneath the page header on the right and looks like a pencil.*) For this tutorial I will be editing a character of mine, Jane Bloggs.




2. Go to the text field where you wish to add a link. In this example, I am going to edit her background.




3. A row of **Add Link** buttons should appear along the bottom of the text field. Click the one that corresponds to the type of page you wish to link to see a dropdown list. I'm going to add a character link.



4. Select the page you wish to link to. A link code will appear in the text field. In this example, I'm picking Joe Bloggs.



5. Save your changes by clicking on the **Save** button. (*It can be found underneath the page header on the right and looks like a floppy disk.*) Alternatively, click on the **SAVE CHANGES** button to the right.



6. Your link will now be visible.
