

# *What should I bring to Stake YW Camp 2026?*

## **Bedding:**

- Twin bed mattress cover (to go over the mattress provided by the state park)
- Sheets/blanket or sleeping bag
- Pillow

## **Clothes:**

- Clothes & shoes for kayaking/canoeing/water games (swimsuit)
- Hat for shade on your lovely face
- Sunglasses
- Rain jacket or poncho
- Pajamas
- Sweatshirt for cool evening weather (one can hope)
- Shoes you can comfortably walk a mile in
- Clothes for Tuesday-Friday:
  - pants/shorts
  - Tshirts
  - Socks
  - Underwear

## **Toiletries:**

- Shower shoes/flipflops (ones you don't mind getting wet)
- Towel/washcloth
- shampoo/conditioner
- Soap/facewash/lotion
- Deodorant
- Toothpaste/Toothbrush
- Tampons/pads

## **Other:**

- Paper copy of scriptures and scripture markers/color pencils
- Flashlight (other than your phone flashlight)
- Bug spray/Sunscreen
- Water bottle (refillable)
- Backpack or drawstring bag
- Wristwatch (one that does NOT need to be recharged)
- Camp chair (optional, but nice to have for your cabin's porch)
- Anything that might make you feel more comfortable that fits in your luggage (optional)

## **Secret Sister items:**

- 1 or 2 small gifts that together equal less than \$5

## **DAYTON STAKE YW CAMP 2026 GUIDELINES**

Dayton Stake YW Camp 2026 guidelines will follow the standards outlined in [\*For the Strength of Youth: A Guide for Making Choices\*](#) for all youth and adults.

### **CLOTHING GUIDELINES**

- See above for what attire to bring to camp.
- Footwear should be appropriate for the activity and worn in all public areas.

### **BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES**

*“Treat everyone as a child of God. As a disciple of Jesus Christ, you can lead out in treating (all) people ... with love, respect, and inclusion. Reach out to those who feel lonely, isolated, or helpless. Help them feel Heavenly Father’s love through you.... Your words can be powerful. Let them be powerful for good.” (For the Strength of Youth: A Guide for Making Choices)*

*“Hazing, pranks, and other unkind, immoral, or disrespectful conversation and behavior are unacceptable.” (Young Women Camp Guide)*

*“Youth should understand that participation in an activity is not a right but a privilege that can be revoked if they behave inappropriately or if they pose a risk to themselves or others.” (Young Women Camp Guide)*

**\*\*We must show respect to the Versailles Stake Park property and the personal belongings of those around us. Any damage, theft, or vandalism of property is very serious and you and your parents will be held responsible, legally and financially.**

### **CELL PHONE GUIDELINES AT CAMP:**

*“The location of your Young Women camp—whether it is in a forest, in a park, on a beach, or in a meetinghouse—can become beautiful to the eyes of all who gather there. Like Alma and his people, young women need a place where they can gather together, separate from worldly influences, feel the Spirit of the Lord, grow in unity and love, and strengthen their faith and testimonies of Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ.” (Young Women Camp Guide”)*

- The campers will be allowed to bring their phones to camp
  - The phones will rest in a collective safe box in campers’ cabins during the day
  - Campers will have access to their phones in the morning after they wake up and night time right before they go to bed. The rest of the day the phones will not be on the campers.
  - The YCL leaders will have their phones with them in case of an emergency
  - Adult leaders will have their phones with them in case of an emergency
