In addition to universal instruction	In place of universal instruction
A service- including accommodations, modifications, and other supports	Just focused on accommodations or modifications
Occurs in a range of educational settings	Just the responsibility of the special education teacher
Based on specific skills a student does NOT have in order to access and progress in the general curriculum, but also strengths of the student	A restatement of the grade level academic content standards being taught in the general education classroom
Instruction written into the IEP that is provided to help student progress towards annual goal(s), and based on the student's needs	Instruction that is based on something other than what has been pinpointed as a student's needs .
Delivered across the MTSS Framework – across Universal, Targeted and Intensive Services	A schedule or a place
Instruction that allows a student to make progress in the general education curriculum, and close the gap in academic performance as compared to their general education peers	An excuse for setting low expectations or teaching below grade level (not making grade level content available/accessible to students with disabilities)

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
