


Faculty Authored Open Textbook (FAOT) AY 2022-2023

OVERVIEW

The Faculty Authored Open Textbook (FAOT) award is available to one full-time faculty member seeking to create and publish an original, complete open textbook for adoption in courses at NJIT. Proposals should be submitted as part of the normal sabbatical application process. Completed applications are due by no later than Friday, October 1, 2021. The FAOT recipient will be awarded by the Provost from among the list of approved sabbatical applications selected by the University Committee on Sabbaticals.

Faculty who are applying for sabbatical must complete and include the FAOT Application Requirements Form below to be considered for the AY 2022-2023 FAOT award.

FUNDING CATEGORY

- Author of Open Textbook: one award for eligible faculty members to publish an open textbook


INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION

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
