


PROGRAM UPDATES

UC for Everyone

Wednesday, March 9th 7:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.

UC will offer a free event for students and families who are interested in learning more about UC admission and campuses. The program theme is Destination UC: Fuel Your Future, and welcomes students in grades 9–11, or in their first year at community college. Students who have already applied should plan to attend campus events in April and May.

This event will help students discover what kinds of learning and engagement opportunities are available in and out of class. They will learn more about what current students are researching and why. Alumni will discuss their perspectives on why UC is a valuable investment. They will get tips on preparing for both freshman and transfer admission. Finally, they will hear from current students and parents about their experiences with UC. Campus admission staff will present, and each undergraduate campus will have admission representatives available to answer questions.

T-Mobile Changemaker Challenge

Deadline: March 31st 2022

Now through March 31, 2022 (9 PM PST), young people ages 13-18 located in the U.S. and Puerto Rico with bold ideas for driving digital empowerment, putting equity into action, and supporting a thriving planet, can enter the Changemaker Challenge. Join us to hear directly from Briana Randall, Executive Director of the Career & Internship Center at the University of Washington, where she will discuss UW's digital-first approach to Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Access (IDEA) efforts. Briana will highlight how her team has

evolved its workflows to provide curated resources for students from unique backgrounds and identities, which have been instrumental in helping them scale support services for BIPOC, LGBTQ+, undocumented, and students with disabilities, just to name a few. By creating a digital space for these resources, one that is openly accessible and highly visible, they have been able to increase their utilization and ultimately their impact.

This talk will focus on conceptualization of antiracism by a survey of how the law and equity advocates frame and understand racism and equal protection. Associate Provost Yildirim will discuss the evolution of U.S. Supreme Court decisions that have defined equity and equal protection, and their impact on antiracist advocacy. She will also focus on how antiracism and equal protection advocates have reframed and argued for a more purposeful approach to combating racism and the lessons we can learn as a university community from these frameworks.

New CalYouth Study Finds Greater Investments Needed to Support College Students with Foster Care Backgrounds

A new <u>report</u> from Chapin Hall found that foster youth from California are enrolling in college campuses across the state and nation. A review of records of close to 8,000 youth found enrollment in 515 distinct college campuses, which includes 217 institutions in California and 298 out-of-state institutions. California public 2-year colleges were by far the most attended institutions, with 82.2% of students first enrolling in one of these schools.

Fertile Ground: Teachers' Growth Mindsets Support Successful Interventions for Students
Every seed has the potential to grow, but the ability of any given seedling to sprout depends
largely on the quality of its environment. Similarly, students' academic outcomes are often
impacted by their teachers' mindsets, according to research by David S. Yeager (The
University of Texas at Austin) and colleagues in Psychological Science.
