Introduction

The introduction consists of the following main elements:

The rationale for choosing a topic; the relevance of the topic or problem. The rationale for choosing a topic based on the experience of predecessors indicates recognition of the problem (the absence of any research, the appearance of a new object, etc.). Relevance is determined by the general interest in the study of the object and is confirmed by the theoretical and practical importance of the topic. Definition of the object, subject, goals, objectives, tasks, methods, approaches, hypothesis and significance of your work. The purpose of the research is related to the proof of the thesis, that is, the presentation of the subject of the research in the aspect chosen by the author.

Literature review

This section should cover fundamental and new works on the subject under study by foreign authors in English, an analysis of these works in terms of their scientific contribution, as well as research gaps that you supplement in your article.

It is UNACCEPTABLE to have a lot of links unrelated to the work, or inappropriate judgments about your own achievements, links to your previous work.

References to cited works in the text are given in brackets, indicating the first author of the work, year of publication: the number of pages. For example, (Zalessky, 1991: 25). In the case of the presence in the list of references of several works of the same author, published in one year, then in addition to the year of publication a letter "a", "b", etc. For example, (Saduova, 2001a: 15), (Saduova, 2001b: 22).

Methodology

This part should consist of a description of the materials, the progress of the work, as well as a complete description of the methods used. The characterization or description of the research material includes the presentation of the specified material in qualitative and quantitative terms. The characteristic of the material is one of the factors determining the reliability of the conclusions and research methods.

This section describes how the problem was studied: detailed information without repeating previously published established procedures; identification of equipment (software) and description of materials are used, with mandatory novelty when using materials and methods.

The scientific methodology should include:

- a research question;
- the proposed hypothesis (thesis);
- stages of the study;
- research methods;

Results and discussion

This section reveals the basic concept of the work and contains an analysis and discussion of the results of the study, as well as conclusions based on the results obtained during the study. The results and discussion is one of the most important sections of the article. It is necessary to analyze the results of current work and discuss them in comparison with previous works, make analysis and conclusions.

Tables

The tables must be created in Microsoft Word spreadsheet format. Tables should be numbered and indicated by numbers in the text. Place the title on the left edge above the table and enter explanatory footnotes (indicated by lowercase letters in the upper index) under the table. The data should be placed in separate cells of the table to prevent text and numbers from shifting when converting the table for publication on the Internet. Empty cells can be inserted to create an interval. Tables should not duplicate the information provided in the text. Instead, tables should be used to provide additional information that illustrates or expands on the specific point that the author wishes to highlight.

Illustrations

All figures should be numbered with arabic numerals (1, 2, ...). All photos, diagrams, graphs and schemes should be marked as figures. Inscriptions and symbols must be clearly defined either in the caption or in the legend that is part of the figure. The figures should be placed as close as possible to the first mention of them in the article. However, if two images fit together, they can be placed next to each other to save space.

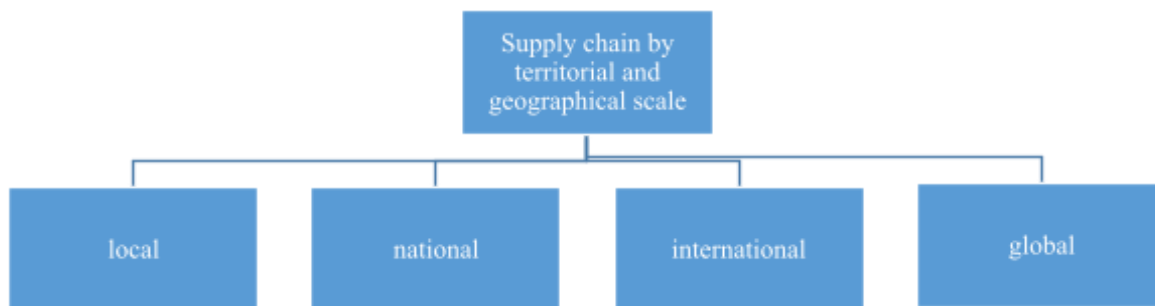


Figure 1 – The name of the picture

The number of figures, tables, graphs and diagrams should not exceed 20% of the total volume of the article (in some cases up to 30%).

Equations

Equations and formulas should be typed in Mathtype and numbered sequentially with Arabic numerals in parentheses on the right side of the page. They should also be separated from the surrounding text by a single space.

Conclusion

The final part includes a generalization and summing up of the work at the current stage; confirmation of the validity of the author's statement and conclusion about the change in scientific knowledge, taking into account the results obtained. The conclusions should be accurate and used to summarize the results of research in specific scientific fields with a description of proposals or opportunities for further work.

The structure of the conclusion should contain the following questions: What are the goals and methods of the study? What are the results? What are the conclusions? What are the prospects and opportunities for the implementation and application of the development?

Gratitude, conflict of interest

Specify the sources of funding and other contributions, acknowledgements, and conflicts of interest.

List of literature

References consists of at least 15 titles, and from the total number of titles in English must be at least 50%.

If there are works presented in Cyrillic in the list of references, it is necessary to submit the list of references in two versions: the first – in the original, the second – in the romanized alphabet (transliteration - translit-online.ru).

The list of references is presented in alphabetical order, and ONLY those works that are cited in the text.

Only essential references that are directly referenced in the text should be included in the reference list.

This section should take into account:

- The main scientific publications, advanced research methods, which are used in this field of science and on which the author's work is based, are cited.
- Avoid excessive self-citations.

– Avoid excessive references to publications of the authors of the CIS / USSR, use world experience.

– The bibliographic list should contain the fundamental and most relevant works published by well-known foreign authors and researchers on the topic of the article.

Style of design of the Romanised list of literature, as well as sources in English (other foreign language) for socio-humanitarian directions – American Psychological Association (<http://www.apastyle.org/>).

The romanized list of references should look like this: author(s) (transliteration) → (year in parentheses) → the title of the article in the transliterated version [translation of the title of the article into English in square brackets], the name of the Russian-language source (transliteration, or English title, if any), output data with notation in English.
