Grant

GRANT LENGTH and GRANT AMOUNT

1. July 1st, 2024, through June 30th, 2025
2. \$350,000 award

This grant will be offered for the next 10+ years and SWODA plans to reapply every year.

TARGET AREA

1. 8 counties – Beckham, Custer, Greer, Harmon, Jackson, Kiowa, Roger Mills, Washita

PERSONNEL

2. Salaries, benefits, mileage, conference registrations, travel, dues to organizations, subscriptions, computers

GENERAL SUPPLIES

1. Office supplies, postage, copier, computer software (MS Office, Adobe), printing,

NALOXONE SATURATION:

1. SWODA will provide naloxone vending machines to organizations and businesses in this 8-county service area.
2. SWODA will provide overdose emergency kits to organizations, businesses, and schools in this 8-county service area. There are two options:
 - Red Box that will be affixed to the wall in the organization, business or school.
 - Purple Pouch that can be stored in the AED case, in a desk drawer or carried in organizations, businesses, or school vehicles.

ACCIDENTAL POISONING/OVERDOSE PREVENTION:

1. SWODA will provide naloxone training to organizations, businesses, and schools in this 8-county service area.
2. SWODA will Distribute Rx Med Lock Bags in the 8-county service area.
3. SWODA Distribute Rx Med At-Home Disposal Kits (Deterra) in the 8-county service area.
4. SWODA will host or partner with other organizations to do Drug Take Back Events in the 8-county service area.

DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING:

1. SWODA will collect MOUs to document partnerships and efforts.
2. SWODA will collect demographic data from vending machines, training, and distribution of resources.
3. SWODA will distribute Naloxone Report Back Forms to community partners to document if/when the med was used to reverse overdose.

INCREASE AWARENESS OF LOCAL RESOURCES AND EFFORTS:

1. Naloxone inserts that have information about naloxone and where to seek out treatment in the area will be placed inside each box of naloxone.
2. Document holders to show:
 - a. How/where to order more Naloxone
 - b. Recognize Overdose and How to Respond
 - c. Promote local prevention efforts and/or recovery resources.
 - d. Promote 888 Crisis line
