8th Science

We are about halfway through a unit about waves and energy. This unit is more challenging and a bit more like a high school class. Students are learning about the different types of energy, how energy is conserved in a system (one experiment and one engineering project for this), how mass and velocity affect kinetic energy, the different types of waves and parts of waves, and how waves behave.

Our final unit of the year will be chemistry. We will learn about chemical reactions, review the reactions for photosynthesis and cellular respiration, and balance chemical equations.

I am using Unified Classroom/PowerSchool to keep track of work completion and assessment scores in science. Students will also be scored on the Habits of Work. I will also be reporting conventional grades for 8th grade. The goal is to familiarize students with how they'll be scored in high school. You can login to Unified Classroom by going to classroom.powerschool.com. You login using your child's gmail account. He/she can show you how to do this and how to navigate around the site.

The 5th grade class took an afternoon field trip on Thursday to Ocean Point Marina in East Boothbay to harvest the sugar kelp and alaria that were put into the Damariscotta River on December 22, 2022. We grew the seedlings in our classroom for almost two months prior to then. We took measurements of the kelp and the water. We fertilized them once a week. The longest blade on the sugar kelp was about 10 cm in December.

At the harvest, the longest blade was 296 cm! And it weighed 29.5 pounds. Our alaria was even shorter when it was put in the river and grew to 319 cm and 29.5 lbs! This project is a multi-school collaboration through the Boothbay Sea and Science Center aimed at helping aquaculturists better understand seaweed farming and to test new ideas.
