

National Team Selection Event and National Short Course Championship 2024

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO HOST

Introduction:

ASRL is seeking Expressions of Interest from Clubs who may be interested in hosting the 2024 National Team Selection Event (NTSE) and National Short Course Championship (NSCC) 2024 to be conducted from 6th – 8th December 2024.

Background Information

Event 1:

The National Team Selection Event will determine which Open and Under 23 crews of each gender will be selected in the SLSA Australian Surf Boat team to compete against New Zealand in the Trans-Tasman Test to be held in New Zealand on (TBA). The ASRL has been contracted to run this event for and on behalf of SLSA

This event will attract the best crews in the country for a 1-day event to be held on Friday 6th December 2024. Racing will be conducted over a full-length course.

Event 2:

The SLSA National Short Course Championship will be run over the weekend of the 7th & 8th December 2024. This SLSA Championship event will have medals awarded in all divisions U19 through to Opens. The ASRL Mixed Crew racing is included at the end of the days racing across Sat & Sun

Host Club Benefits:

As the host venue, your club receives a range of benefits for holding this event in your local region.

Club Culture

Hosting a national event provides your members with the opportunity to enhance comradery and pride in the club. Often host clubs use this opportunity to draw on a wider pool of volunteers to engage in the club and bring the junior and senior divisions together as one team.

Local and State Profile

By hosting the NTSE & NSCC your club will be promoted to the wider network of clubs around Australia in anticipation of the event. Livestream for the events will occur over the weekend. Furthermore, media exposure is possible along with social media generated by ASRL. This is an opportunity to showcase your club both within and external to surf lifesaving.

Host Fee

ASRL will provide a hosting fee to the club for provision of services defined in a hosting MOU. This includes administrative delivery, facilities and equipment, volunteer personnel and event support.

- **Officials Catering:** ASRL provides the host club with the opportunity to cater for 30+ officials for breakfast, morning tea, lunch and debrief. ASRL meets the cost for Officials catering(price to be determined in MOU). This is not included in the host fee.
- **Refreshments :** At the conclusion of competition, your club can operate a club bar (within your current liquor license) to service officials, competitors and supporters alike.
- **BBQ:** Your club could leverage from 500+ competitors, 30+ officials and 200+ supporters to operate a BBQ fundraiser for the duration of competition, in a prime position.
- **Parking:** The host club is provided the opportunity to establish parking areas for competitors and charge a reasonable fee for parking within this area
- **Local Council Support:** Successful host clubs may be able to access local event grants.

Venue & Event Requirements

1 On Beach

Item	Description	Dimension	Additional Information
1.1	2 x Surf Boat comp area, straight edge at water's edge.	400m wide	Consideration to 14 'fair' alleys
1.2	Water Area (includes competition, warm up/warm down, buffer and power craft access zones)	600m of usable water area	
1.3	Minimum beach width	30m wide	Measured at high tide
1.4	Minimum of 2 pedestrian beach access points	3m wide	
1.5	Minimum of 1 beach vehicle access points	3m wide	
1.6	No Rocks & Reefs within proposed competition area		

2 Back of beach

Item	Description	Dimension	Additional Information
2.1	Officials briefing/ catering/ licensed refreshment area		This area should be in close proximity to each other and as close as possible to the main competition areas. This could be part of the existing clubhouse.
2.2	Secure room for storing merchandise and equipment/ Admin location		Will need power points for charging radios. Event Team will need access to the room and Admin room for the duration of the event
2.3	Helicopter Landing Site	40m x 40m	Must be within a reasonable distance to the competition area.
2.4	First Aid area		Must have direct access to the beach. This may be part of the existing clubhouse.
2.5	Sponsor activation area	6x4m	Close to competition area

3 Contingency Location

Item	Description
3.1	The proposed alternative venues should face a different direction and prevailing conditions to that of the main venue
3.2	Two alternative locations should be nominated, meeting similar requirements of the proposed venue, i.e. minimum width of 400m.
3.3	Include maps of the proposed alternative venues
3.4	Sufficient access for vehicles
3.5	All successful venues will need to be available to host the Back Up Round if required

4 Other logistical requirements

Item	Description
4.1	Accessible to adequate emergency services including hospital and ambulance service
4.2	Access to medical, pharmaceutical, dental, physio and chiropractic services
4.3	The venue must be available to the ASRL from Tuesday 3pm prior to the event until 3pm Monday.
4.4	A designated Trailer location for parking approx. 75 boat trailers
4.5	Gear compound to house: 20ft Container +/- 40ft container, 2 Trailers approx. 7.5m in length each, 4 x Event vehicles & 2 x Site Sheds.

When negotiating the Host Club MOU the payment made by the ASRL for hosting the event will be dependent on the level of support/personnel that the club can provide to support the event.
