

Make sure you leave room for YOU to be added to the picture.






Set the stage for perfect selfies

Which YOU fits best?


Consider enlisting an assistant to get the best poses and full-body pics for more options.






Virtual Field Trip images


Import the location images into WeVideo.



Place these images into Video 1 track back to back.




By default each image will play for 5 seconds. Click on an image and use the arrows on the right to shrink it or grow it to make it play for less or more time.



Pictures of you

Import the images of you into WeVideo.




Place the images into Video 2 track back to back lining them up with the location where you want each pose.



If you adjusted the timing of the location images, you will

need to adjust the timing of these images as well. Use the directions above to shrink or grow with the arrows.
