## 4.16.2020

Changes to the Public Health Stay-At-Home Order will go into effect on April 23rd.

**Maximum Group Size:** No change to the current PH order. All events of more than five people not of the same household are prohibited. Households greater than five engaging in essential activities together are exempt, but must follow social distancing.

**Construction:** Construction projects with a submitted and approved COVID-19 Site Safety Plan and adherence to social distancing requirements as described in current public health order are permitted to operate.

**Landscaping:** Landscaping companies with a completed COVID-19 Business Safety Plan and adherence to social distancing requirements as described in current public health order are permitted to operate. This requires the industry's participation in developing a standard safety plan with components all companies would need to address in their individual safety plans.

**Lodging:** No change to the current PH order. Hotels, motels, short term rentals (30 days or less), bed and breakfast, lodges and retreats closed except for essential workers and isolation and guarantine needs.

**Golf Courses:** Golf courses can remain open for outdoor activities with the submission and approval of a Business Safety plan; however, Social Distancing Requirements must be strictly followed. Clubhouses, restaurants, snack bars and pro shops must not be open and tee times and golf fee transactions made only online. Only household members may share a golf cart or be a caddy for a golfer. Golfers are strongly encouraged to not touch any equipment that is not their own (e.g. tees and flags).

**Retail:** Permitted retail operations are now aligned with the state public health order, expanding the definition of critical businesses to include: bike repair and office supplies.

Places of Public Accommodation: No change to the current PH order. Places of public accommodation (defined in Order Section III(D)) and similar establishments except that such establishments may provide takeout or delivery of food or sale of alcohol by package, social distancing required, maximum 5 allowed in establishment at a time. Indoor and outdoor seating shall be designated as closed, and made unavailable to the public to prevent public gathering.

Quarantine requirement for Non-resident homeowners: No change to the current PH Order. Quarantine requirement for Non-resident homeowners, family, friends and guests returning to their residence after the date of this Order required to self-quarantine for a period of fourteen (14) days.
