Timing	Engage - 1 day Explore - 2 days Explain - 1 for song, 2-6 days for articles Apply - 3 days Share - 1-4 days (Fun, AVID Family Activities) Reflect - 1 day Extend - WRITE OFF - 45 minutes *Times are estimates and may need to be adjusted for your class needs. All materials are suggested and not required.
Set Up	ENGAGE - Materials: - Class poster and sticky notes for guessing theme - Class poster for t-chart of pro/con list - Prepare: - Google Survey Link for your class. (Make a copy.) - eBinder link ready for students to make a copy - Decide on which articles you will have them read and consider deleting the slides for the other articles. You can also leave them in if students want to explore more on their own. EXPLORE - Materials: - 4 labels for 4 Corners activity - 4 posters to collect discussion notes from Socratic Seminar - Lots of sticky notes - Prepare: - Learn some AVID Claps and choose ones you want to use - Preview TED Talk

EXPLAIN Materials: Print copies of articles chosen if you want students to mark on them.
