- o **Camp for All** – Volunteered at Camp for All located in Burton, Texas three separate summers. Worked preparing meals for the week for residents with strict dietary, cleaned the dining hall and kitchen, helped handicapped campers to participate in ‘Water Day’ activities, cleaned and organized an enormous costume room for campers to put on plays, and washed dishes for breakfast and lunch service. Total of 21 hours
- o **Bay Area Turning Point** –Worked at the BATP Resale shop cleaning and organizing the shop and donation areas and tagging/pricing items to be sold. Have worked 2 years during their ‘Fill the Truck’ campaign by soliciting donations at a local grocery store and by working at the food pantry receiving food donations, sorting, and restocking the pantry.
