Midway ISD is excited to offer an **Accelerated Math Pathway** for students who demonstrate advanced mathematical understanding and readiness. This pathway is designed for students who are ready to move at a significantly faster pace, completing multiple years of math in a condensed time frame.

In this program, students begin in **6th Grade** with an **Accelerated Math 8** course that prepares them for **Algebra I**. To qualify for the Accelerated Math 8 course, students must pass **two Credit-by-Exam (CBE) assessments**—one for **Math 6** and one for **Math 7**—with a score of **80% or higher** on each. These exams ensure that students have fully mastered the foundational concepts required by the state of Texas and needed to succeed in the Accelerated Math Pathway.

This rigorous pathway enables students to access math courses earlier than the on-level or advanced pathways. It is ideal for learners who are passionate about math, enjoy academic challenges, and are committed to maintaining high performance.

Please note that while we maintain an open enrollment policy, continued success in this pathway requires students to meet prerequisite knowledge and consistently demonstrate academic commitment.
