Pre-requisites:	NCEA Literacy, plus a minimum of 15 L1 English credits or with Curriculum Leader's approval.				
Course description:	<p>A mainstream English course including both internal and external assessment. Students will show a discriminating understanding of ideas, language features, and how texts are created and structured for different purposes and audiences.</p> <p>The course will cover 5 Achievement Standards (3 internal and 2 external). Students are able to gain up to 24 credits towards Level 2 NCEA (16 Internal credits and 8 External credits).</p> <p>University Entrance Literacy is NOT a requirement to pass NCEA Level 2 but is required to pass University Entrance and for entry to Level 3 English. To pass UE Literacy, students need 5 Reading and 5 Writing credits which they can gain from a range of specified AS in English and other subjects at Level 2 or 3. In this course, 14 credits count towards UE Literacy Reading and 14 credits count towards UE Literacy Writing.</p> <p>Students can pass UE Literacy internally in this course by achieving <b>both</b> AS91101 <b>and</b> AS91204.</p> <p><b>To continue to ENG3 in 2026 students must pass UE literacy and at least 16 credits from the standards below, including at least one English external.</b></p>
