- Heart Disease or Disorder (requires written physician approval)
- Blood Disorder (requires written physician approval)
- Epilepsy
- Taking blood thinners (requires written physician approval)
- Clotting disorders (requires written physician approval)
- History of Keloid Scarring
- History of Hypertrophic Scarring
- Diabetes (requires written physician approval)
- Taking ARV's
- Psoriasis
- Active Herpes Outbreak (cold sore)
- Herpes Simplex
- Hepatitis
- Autoimmune Disorder (depending on the disorder a written physician approval is required)
- Allergies to Metal
- Undergoing Chemotherapy or Radiation
- Recent Surgeries on the area to be treated
- Moles, Lesions, Sores on the treatment area
- Infectious Skin or Blood Disorders
- Use of Accutane within the last 12 months
- Current use of Retinol
- Healing Disorders
- Claustrophobia
