

Coaching, Sports Camps and Events - Booking Terms & Conditions

Bookings Generally

- All bookings must be made online via the Rhosneigr Sports Club website.
- The booker (i.e., the person who makes a booking) will be held responsible for that booking.
- Bookings for children (under 18's) should be made by adults (18 and over.
- It is the responsibility of the booker to inform Rhosneigr Sports Club and also the Coaching staff. Sports Camp staff or Event staff of any medical conditions / disabilities that they should be aware of and to give details of any medication that may be needed or that is taken.
- If stated and/or as necessary, participants should bring a packed lunch, water in an unbreakable bottle and sun cream in warm weather.
- Sports shoes with flat soles must be worn at all times on the MUGA and bowling green.
- Studded football shoes/boots and high heels are strictly forbidden.

No food is allowed into the MUGA or on the bowling green.

- Shin pads should be worn for football activities
- Alcohol is strictly forbidden on RSC premises.
- Chewing gum is strictly forbidden on RSC premises.
- Smoking is strictly forbidden on RSC premises.
- Dogs are strictly forbidden on RSC premises.
- Littering is strictly forbidden on RSC premises.
- Persons behaving in a manner likely to disrupt the enjoyment of, or endanger other users or neighbours of RSC may be asked to leave. No refunds will be given.
- RSC reserves the right to terminate a booking if these T&C's are not followed.

Cancellations

- RSC: If a coaching session is cancelled by us (due to bad weather, illness or insufficient numbers etc) a refund or credit will be applied to your account Reasonable notice (24 hours) will be given whenever possible.
- You: Contact us via rhosneigrsportsclub@gmail.com at the earliest opportunity If you need to cancel your booking. We are happy to offer a full refund or credit if we have enough time (24hrs minimum) to re-advertise the place(s). For late cancellations (less than 24 hrs) we may be able to offer a credit, but this will depend on whether the place(s) can be filled.
- Credits are valid for a reasonable time period and may be used on future bookings.

- RSC accepts no responsibility for any personal injuries which occur during sports activities.
