Ahoy. It's June 7th, 2021, I'm Kim, and the frog of the week is the Amazon Milk Frog.

This frog is also known as the mission-golden-eyed tree frog or the blue milk tree frog. It lives high in the canopies of the Amazon Rainforest. In fact, it often lays its eggs in water-filled holes in trees, meaning it rarely, if ever, descends to the ground.

The Amazon Milk Frog is grayish-blue in color, with black or brown banding This coloring is more pronounced in young frogs but fades as they grow older. The name "milk frog" is derived from a foul-smelling, poisonous, milky substance the frog secretes when it is stressed, but I prefer it's Portuguese name: sapo canoeiro, meaning "boatman frog." That name is derived from its call, which according to some, sounds like oars tapping on the side of a canoe.
