# The Class of 2025 COLLEGE PREPARATION CHECKLIST

Are you prepared for Senior Year? Are you considering applying to College? Have you done the following?

1. Did you submit the **TRANSCRIPT RELEASE FORM** (HERE) to Guidance? (*REQUIRED*)

Due by <u>June 18, 2024</u>. We must have this form on file before we can send out your transcript and supporting materials to colleges/universities/scholarships.

- 2. Please be advised that the Guidance Office suggests that you ask at least two (2) academic teachers for a college recommendation TEACHER RECOMMENDATION FORMS (HERE).
  - ASK YOUR TEACHER FIRST before giving them a form.
  - Please give **two** (2) **teachers** the <u>Teacher Recommendation Form</u> by the end of **May** (latest by June 13). If you do not give the teachers this form, they <u>WILL NOT</u> write a recommendation for you....this is a REQUIRED form. Do not delay!
  - Teacher Forms go directly to the teacher do not give them to guidance.
- 3. Make sure to update your Personal Bio and Activities/Achievements in SCOIR account by the end of the school year (*REQUIRED*):
  - Teachers & Guidance will have access to your SCOIR account list of
    activities/achievements, so please make sure that is up-to-date! ALL teachers &
    counselors <u>require</u> this item to be completed when writing a student's recommendation!
- 4. You MUST complete and turn in a **RESUME** in your GOOGLE Classroom. (**REQUIRED**)

*HINT*: Make sure that you also complete the Common App Top 10 Activities/Top 5 Honors

Packet (GOOGLE DOC or packet). This will help you keep your activities/jobs/community
service all organized. If you already have a Resume - upload it to your Google Class of 2025

- 5. Did you fill out the GUIDANCE MEMO (GOOGLE DOC)? (REQUIRED)
  This form MUST be completed in your Guidance Class 2025 Google Classroom in order for a counselor recommendation to be written. Make sure to get started on this early, there are a lot of questions and you just might find that one of your answers would be a great college essay!!!
  REMEMBER—This is a REQUIRED form!! Please have this completed by the end of the year June 18, 2024.
- 6. Give a person or persons in your family the BRAG SHEET' FOR COLLEGE RECOMMENDATIONS (HERE). While this is not required, we find that parents give wonderful information to include in the Guidance Recommendation. Family members are welcome to email their answers to Ms. Kafkalas.

HINT: More than one person can fill this out for you!

- 7. Make sure to keep the list of colleges you are "FOLLOWING" updated in SCOIR.
- 8. IF YOU HAVE Official SAT and/or ACT scores you will want to send them to your schools in September/October 2024 SENIOR YEAR
  - DO NOT send your scores this year (in your Junior Year): If you decide to use test scores as part of admissions Start sending your scores in your Senior Year.
  - Remember- The high school transcript WILL NOT list SAT/ACT scores; it will be YOUR
    responsibility to send your scores directly to your schools.
  - Don't wait too long in the fall to send in your scores. Once you submit your request to College Board and/or ACT, it can take up to three weeks for the scores to be sent and received.
  - Some schools will allow you to **self-report your test scores** (saving you money) (make sure to always check the school's website to learn about their official school testing policy).
  - Keep in mind that many colleges will be <u>TEST-OPTIONAL</u> next year. We will help you strategize on whether you will submit your scores.
  - Upcoming ACT Exams: June 8 and July 13
