

Uniform Washing Instructions

1. Check the serial numbers on the front of the garment bag against the pieces in the bag. There are pieces in the bag and in a zip pocket on the backside of the bag. Note any discrepancies before you put items in the wash.
2. Wash no more than 3-4 uniforms at a time.
3. Pretreat stains – you can use a stain spray, stick, or laundry detergent. Use a nail brush, toothbrush, or scrub material together to remove/pretreat the stain. Check around the ankles and seat of the pants as those will be dirty and then spot check the other pieces.
4. Wash the jacket, pants, skirt, cinch, hat wrap and gauntlets(back of bag). Everything gets washed except for the cinch drop (sparkly tie).
5. Wash on the delicate cycle (low spin/cold tap) with regular laundry detergent.
6. Dry on low
7. Put everything back in the same bag.
