### **Essential Outcomes:**

**Course Description:** In this class, students will be expected to develop and execute creative imagery in their artwork that demonstrates evidence of personal imagery using a variety of drawing media while maintaining a high level of excellence in both technical and conceptual problem solving. Students will be expected to follow Drawing goals and guidelines and meet strict deadlines. Sketchbooks are an integral part of this course. At the end of each project a class critique will be used to evaluate and discuss each artist's work. Art History, technology and other disciplines will be incorporated as they apply to each project. All assignments will be posted in Canvas and finished works will be uploaded to Canvas
