How does Loss of Privilege (LOP) affect my participation in the Graduation and Senior Activities?

Seniors on the LOP list due to academic grades and/or citizenship and/or attendance will not be allowed to participate in Graduation and Senior Activities.

Attendance LOP occurs when you have a total of 5 or more unexcused Tardies or ABSENCES for the year (attendance codes A, T, U, W, Z). Instructional Recovery Time (IRT) is the best way to 'clear' absences. Keep it simple: Don't be late or absent. If so, get it cleared!

Conferences & Appeals - CHS Seniors on the LOP list will have the chance to go through an appeal process and have their privileges (i.e. participation in Senior activities, walking in graduation, etc.) reinstated.

- Appeals are only held for Seniors that have been suspended fewer than 5 days. There will only be one session of appeals; any suspension thereafter will not be granted an appeal.
- No appeals are held for tardies and uncleared absences; it is the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian to maintain proper attendance and follow guidelines throughout the school year.
- Seniors at risk of non-participation in Senior Activities will be conferenced at least a month before Senior Activities and notified at least 1 week prior to Senior Activities.

All Seniors are held to this standard.
