

## **Event Terms and Conditions**

### **The Proximity Marketplace**

My Write Hand Woman ("Host") is hosting The Proximity Marketplace in Austin, Texas, on Thursday, November 12, 2026 ("**Event**").

Please read these Terms and Conditions ("**Terms**") carefully before purchasing a ticket to the Event. You should read these Terms in conjunction with the Code of Conduct. By purchasing a ticket, you agree to be bound by these Terms and you acknowledge and agree to HOST's Privacy Policy, which can be fully accessed at <https://www.mywritehandwoman.com/privacy-policy>.

These Terms relate both to the sale of tickets and attendance at the Event. These Terms apply to both the original purchaser and any subsequent ticket holders ("you").

These Terms outline the rules and expectations for attending The Proximity Marketplace, including ticket use, refunds, behavior, and safety protocols. Please read them carefully before purchasing your ticket.

### **Conditions of Entry**

1. You must be at least eighteen (18) years of age or older and have the legal capacity to enter into binding contracts to purchase a Ticket.
2. A valid government-issued photo government-issued photo ID (such as a driver's license or passport) is required for the name on the is required for entry to the Event. The ID must be presented along with your ticket for verification purposes.
3. You may be denied entry into, or removed from, the Event for breaching the Code of Conduct, or for any other undesirable or offensive behavior, including behavior that is objectionable to HOST or adversely affecting the enjoyment of the Event by others.
4. Individuals with known symptoms of illness are not permitted to attend the Event. HOST reserves the right to deny entry or remove attendees who appear to be exhibiting symptoms of communicable diseases to ensure the health and safety of all participants.

5. You may be required to submit to a search of your person and/or possessions before entering the event. You acknowledge that HOST is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property. Security of your personal property is the sole responsibility of you. By attending the event, you expressly assume all risks associated with event attendance, including but not limited to potential exposure to illness, injury, or other health-related risks. You agree to waive any and all claims against HOST related to health and safety risks that may arise during the event.

HOST is committed to maintaining a safe and secure environment for all Event attendees. Safety protocols include health screening, potential personal searches, and the right to remove individuals who pose a risk to others' well-being. We prioritize the health, safety, and comfort of all participants and reserve the right to implement additional safety measures as needed to ensure a safe event experience.

6. Event doors open at a time to be determined.

7. You may not be permitted to use cameras or other photographic or recording equipment (including mobile phones) at the Event.

8. HOST is committed to complying with all applicable accessibility laws, including the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and to providing reasonable accommodations to ensure equal access for attendees can fully participate in the Event. Attendees requiring special accommodations are encouraged to contact our Accessibility Support Team at [hello@mywritehandwoman.com](mailto:hello@mywritehandwoman.com) at least 14 days prior to the event. Please include your specific needs and contact info so we can support you. Our team will review each request and respond within 14 business days to discuss available support options and confirm arrangements.

9. By attending the event, you and each attendee in your group acknowledge and agree that you each may be filmed, photographed and/or recorded and you each give permission to HOST to use your image, likeness and voice obtained at the Event in all media throughout the world for any purpose and without any compensation. All professional recording rights (audio/video) are exclusively reserved by HOST as the event organizer. promotional, marketing, and other commercial purposes related to HOST's business worldwide in perpetuity. You waive any right to inspect or approve such use and acknowledge that you will receive no compensation for such use.

11. Attendees are permitted to share personal, non-commercial social media content from the Event, such as status updates and personal photos. However, live streaming, sharing of presentation materials, or any content that may infringe on speakers' or HOST's intellectual property rights is strictly prohibited without prior written consent from HOST.

12. Except as prohibited by applicable law, HOST will not be responsible or liable for any loss, damage or injury arising from your attendance at the Event, except those caused by HOST's gross negligence or willful misconduct. You assume all reasonable risk associated with your attendance at the Event.

13. All intellectual property rights related to the Event, including but not limited to performances, content, presentations, and materials, belong exclusively to HOST and/or its designated speakers and performers. Attendees may not reproduce, distribute, modify, create derivative works from, publicly display, publicly perform, republish, download, store, transmit or use any such content without express written permission from HOST. Any unauthorized use may result in immediate removal from the Event, legal action, and permanent ban from future HOST events. HOST reserves all rights not expressly granted herein.

All trademarks, logos, and branded materials related to the Event are the exclusive property of HOST. Attendees are prohibited from reproducing, distributing, or using HOST's trademarks, logos, or other branded materials without prior written consent. Any unauthorized use of Event-related intellectual property is strictly forbidden and may result in immediate revocation of event access and potential legal action.

## **Refund Policy**

### **No Refunds**

All ticket, table, and sponsorship purchases are final. HOST does not offer refunds, exchanges, or credits for any reason, including but not limited to a change of mind, scheduling conflicts, personal circumstances, travel delays, illness, or external factors such as adverse weather.

### **No Re-Sale or Promotional use**

Tickets to the Event may not be re-sold, on-supplied or transferred for commercial, consumer or promotional purposes, bundled with other goods or services, or used for promotional purposes without HOST's prior written consent. Additionally, any recordings, photographs, or other content captured at the Event may not be used for commercial purposes without explicit written permission from HOST.

## **Food and Drink**

1. You must be 21 years of age or older to order or consume alcohol at the Event. HOST is committed to the responsible service of alcohol, and will enforce the checking of proof of age identification by service providers. You must carry valid proof of age identification at the Event and present it if requested.

2. Intoxicated attendees may be refused service.

3. Outside food or drinks are not allowed on the premises and you may not bring them to the Event.

4. The following items are strictly prohibited at the Event: weapons of any kind, illegal substances, outside food or beverages, professional cameras or recording equipment, drones, laser pointers, noise-making devices, fireworks, flammable objects, and any other items deemed dangerous or disruptive by Event staff. HOST reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone in possession of prohibited items.

## **Privacy Rights**

HOST takes the security of your personal data seriously. We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal information against unauthorized or unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction, or damage.

## **Feedback**

You assign to HOST any suggestions, ideas, enhancement requests, or other feedback you provide to HOST relating to HOST's visual communication platform ("Service") or HOST's products, or the Event ("Feedback"). This includes, without limitation, any written, verbal or other Feedback you provide prior to, during or following the event, in connection with the Event or your attendance at the Event, or in respect of HOST generally. HOST owns all content, data, software, inventions, ideas and other

technology and intellectual property that it develops in connection with the Service and its products.

### **Variations to Event**

HOST reserves the right to modify the event lineup, performers, or program content. In the event of such changes:

1. HOST will make reasonable efforts to maintain the overall quality and intent of the event;
2. Ticket holders will be notified of significant changes to performers or program content;
3. If a key performer or critical program element is substantially changed, ticket holders may be offered a refund;
4. Minor modifications to the event program do not constitute grounds for refund.

HOST reserves the right to change the event venue due to unforeseen circumstances, including but not limited to safety concerns, venue unavailability, or capacity limitations. In the event of a venue change, HOST will notify ticket holders via email and/or the Event App, providing details of the new location and any potential impact on ticket validity as soon as reasonably possible.

### **Variations to Event Schedule**

HOST reserves the right to change the event date, time, or venue due to unforeseen circumstances, including but not limited to safety concerns, logistical challenges, or operational requirements. In the event of a date or time change, HOST will notify ticket holders via email as soon as possible. The notification will include: The new date and time of the event, an explanation for the change, options for ticket holders, including refund or alternative attendance, and any additional relevant details about the schedule modification.

### **Variations to the Terms**

1. HOST reserves the right to make changes to these Terms at any time by posting the changes on HOST.com, or such other website or application that is used in connection with the Event.

2. You will be subject to the Terms made available on the relevant website or application at the time of the Event.

## **Dispute Resolution**

Any disputes related to refunds or cancellations must be submitted in writing to HOST's customer service within 7 days of the event or cancellation. Disputes will be reviewed by HOST's event management team, who will provide a final determination within 7 days of receipt. If the dispute cannot be resolved internally, both parties agree to seek resolution through binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, Austin, Texas.

## **Force Majeure**

1. Neither party will be in breach of these Terms, nor have any liability to the other party, if it is prevented from complying with its obligations by reason of any act, event or circumstance beyond the reasonable control of the affected party ("Force Majeure Event"). Force Majeure Events include, but are not limited to, acts of God, war, riot, civil unrest, acts of terrorism, fire, flood, earthquake, epidemic, pandemic, government actions or restrictions, strikes, failure of suppliers or subcontractors, or widespread technology failures.

2. If a Force Majeure Event prevents HOST from being able to host the Event, then HOST's entire liability to you is to refund the ticket cost you have paid to attend the Event. HOST will not be liable to compensate you for any additional losses, including but not limited to airfares or accommodation.

## **Severability**

If any of these clauses in these Terms are deemed invalid, void, or for any reason unenforceable, that term will be deemed severable and will not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining clauses.

## **Code of Conduct**

### **Scope**

All event participants, including but not limited to HOST employees, contractors, event sponsors, external vendors, volunteers, clients, speakers, attendees, and other guests (collectively, "Event Participants") are expected to uphold the principles of this Code of Conduct at all event venues, sessions, and social events hosted by HOST either in person or online.

### **Bullying, Violence, and Harassment**

Event Participants are expected to treat others with dignity, courtesy and respect. Event Participants are entitled to an experience free from bullying, violence, and harassment, in any form, be it physical, emotional, verbal, or sexual.

This may include, but is not limited to:

- Inappropriate language or gestures
- Threatening or abusive behavior (verbal or physical)
- Display of offensive or sexually suggestive objects or images
- Explicit demands for sexual behavior
- Making jokes or derogatory statements that are ethnic, racial, sexual, religious, political, age-related, or disability-related in nature.

We are committed to keeping My Write Hand Woman events a safe place for all Event Participants. If you witness or experience any actions of violence or harassment, you should immediately report such incidents to HOST. HOST will investigate all reports promptly and take appropriate action in accordance with applicable laws. Any acts of bullying, violence, harassment (including sexual harassment) or intimidation will not be tolerated, and may result in being removed from the event, and/or referred to local law enforcement.

### **Respectful Communication**

At My Write Hand Woman, we value professionalism among our staff, which includes demonstrating honesty, respect, integrity, compassion, humility, and accountability, and we expect the same from our community at our in person and online events. We promote open discussion between Event Participants, as well as listening to and sharing perspectives different to our own.

## **Drugs and Alcohol**

When alcohol is served at HOST events, Event Participants must consume alcohol responsibly and in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations, including age restrictions. At no time should Event Participants behave in a manner which is inappropriate. If any Event Participant appears to be intoxicated or is posing a safety risk, HOST and event organizers shall have the absolute right to remove such participant from the event immediately and at their sole discretion. Any illicit substances are strictly prohibited at HOST events.

## **Diversity and Inclusion**

We celebrate the uniqueness that every person brings, and recognize that our success is firmly grounded in the richness of diverse thinking and ideas. We aim to foster event environments that reflect and celebrate the diversity and unique perspectives that exist in the society we live in.

## **Fostering Community Involvement**

When we bring people together, we create a culture of inclusion and openness. We hope that by building awareness of the importance of diversity, equity and inclusion, and providing a safe place to speak about it, we encourage healthy conversations that create positive, lasting change. We are proud to work together with our community partners that inspire and provide opportunities to those that often need it most.

## **Health and Safety**

HOST strives to maintain reasonable health and safety measures for Event Participants. By attending any HOST event, Event Participants acknowledge and agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local health and safety requirements, including but not limited to any posted safety protocols or instructions from HOST personnel.

If you're feeling unwell, please rest up and stay at home so we can continue to keep our fellow event attendees and community safe. In the event of an emergency or security event, Event Participants agree to follow instructions provided by HOST or event personnel.

## **Other Standards of Conduct**

The standards expected of all Event Participants include:

- To maintain the highest standards of personal integrity, honesty, and professional conduct at all times during the event, as determined by HOST in its reasonable discretion;
- To not engage in conduct that, as determined by HOST in its sole discretion, causes or may cause damage to any property or the reputation of HOST or other Event Participants;
- At all times, conduct themselves in a manner consistent with HOST's core values, integrity, and reputation, as determined by HOST in its sole discretion, and refrain from any action or behavior that could reasonably be expected to bring HOST into disrepute.

## **Reporting**

Please immediately report any abusive content or behavior that violates this Code to HOST. While HOST may, in its discretion, assist participants in contacting local law enforcement or provide other reasonable assistance to those experiencing harassment or inappropriate behavior, HOST assumes no obligation or liability in connection with such assistance.
