Origin:

Falabella hails from the pampas of Argentina and is one of the smallest breeds, standing less than eight hands high.

Features:

Strong and compact, they have the slim body and overall proportions of a horse. Falabella have beautiful thick but silky manes and tails. Their neck is muscular, back is short, stout legs, and sloping shoulders. These horses heads have a slightly concave profile, bright eyes, mid-size ears and an alert but kind appearance.

Colors:

Brown and black are the most common coat colours for the Falabella horse. They can also be found in many other hues and combinations, including bay, pinto, and leopard spotted.
