For your modified car

Important Safety Information

Adult supervision is **required at all times** while your child is in their car.

Your child **must** be secured with the seat belt or harness while in the car.

Assess the area for safety before allowing your child to drive the car.

Making the car go

PRESS-TO-GO CARS

This style of car moves forward when your child presses the button, and stops when the button is not pressed.

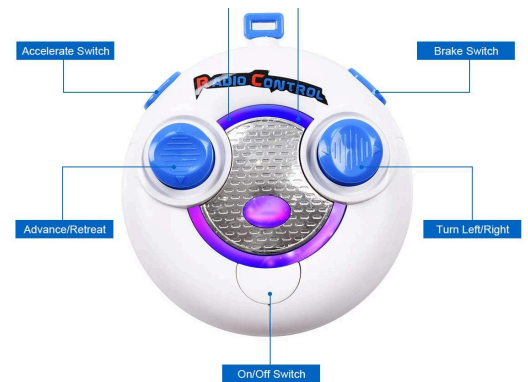


SIT-TO-STAND CARS

This style of car moves forward when your child sits on the seat, and stops when they stand.

REMOTE CONTROL CARS

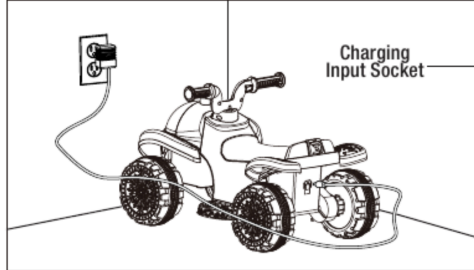
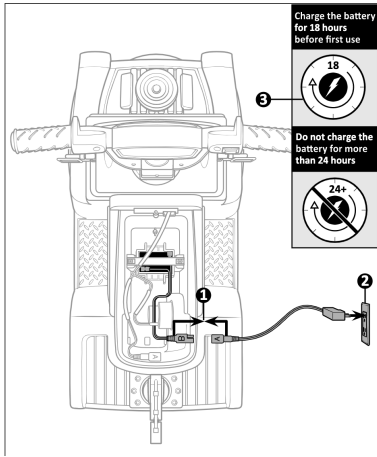
This style of car moves forward when your child presses the button, and stops when the button is not pressed. It can also be operated by an adult using the remote control to steer and make the car go forward and backward.



Additional notes:

Charging the battery

Your car charges in the following way (therapist circle one):

Socket charger (similar to a cell phone)	 Plug in one end of the charger into the socket located: Plug the other end into the wall outlet.
Open the car to charge	 Open the: Locate the battery cable and disconnect it. Plug one end of the charger into the battery cable. Plug the other end into the wall outlet.

Always charge the battery in a dry location. Do not allow children to play on or near the car while it is charging. Do not allow the battery to drain completely.
