CHALLENGE CORNER CREDITS

What Are They and How Do I Earn Them?

★ *What is Challenge Corner Credit?*

Extra credit is not offered in this class, however, students can earn Challenge Corner Credits.

★ *What is Challenge Corner Credit worth?*

- ONE Challenge Corner Credit = 1 point to a test/project
OR

2 points to quiz/mini project

- Different projects are worth different amounts of challenge credits, and simply completing the project does not ensure receiving the full Challenge Corner Credits offered.

★ *Do I have to complete Challenge Corner Credit?*

Challenge Corner Credits is NEVER mandatory, and students will not be penalized if they do not complete this project.

★ *What if I lose my CCCs?*

The student is responsible for keeping the Challenge Corner Credits and redeeming them before the end of the marking period, the teacher will not keep track of these credits.

★ *How do I earn Challenge Corner Credit?*

- **Boggle** - students should copy the letters from the "Boggle Board" and create as many words from the present letters as possible. The letters must be touching in the correct order to create the word. Turn in your completed sheet before the end of the week. CCCs earned will vary.
- **In My Opinion** - utilize the "Quote of the Week" that is posted. Copy the quote onto the provided assignment paper. Write a 7-10 sentence interpretation of the quote. Your explanation should include some sort of connection (text to text, text to world, text to self). Turn in your interpretation by the following Monday for TWO possible Challenge Corner Credits.
- **Read Between the Spines** - Students may complete a book spine for each IRB (independent reading book) completed during 8th grade. Books must be seen being actively read in class for credit! You must complete each required element completely and thoroughly - remember the point is to demonstrate you read and understood your book. (Earn 10 CCCs).
