3. Customization Guide

3.1 General Information

If you run into any issues while trying to customize this theme, please take the time to read the information and help presented in this customization guide first. I will try to explain some basics here, so the customization process is easier for you.

Additionally, before you come to my inbox asking about something, try to do the following things first:

- Read this customization guide.
- Read through the <u>FAQ</u>. Maybe the question has been answered there.
- Read through the <u>support</u> or <u>answered</u> tag on my blog.
- Read through the answers on silbrigsupport.
- Try to google the issue w3schools, stackoverflow and others often have an answer.

If none of that helped you resolve the issue, send me a message via my inbox or the tumblr direct messenger.

Here is some basic etiquette because otherwise I either cannot or do not want to help you:

- Have patience my life is busy and tumblr is not my job.
- Be nice if you insult me, I will just block you.
- Come off anon if you send a question through the inbox.
- Please tell me what problem is occurring, where it is occurring, and ideally also which one of my codes you're using – the more information, the easier it is for me to help you, resulting in a faster answer.

3.2 Colors

There are six fields for colors in the customization panel. The table below lists their names, default color values, and purposes.

1	Accent 1 Saffron (#f2c42f)	BG: selection, marked text, audio without album art, questions, mobile footer¹, mobile nav links. Hover BG: pagination, to top button, link post.
2	Accent 2 Cadmium Red (#de1422)	BG: scrollbar thumb. Border: blockquote². Color: deactivated. Hover color: links, nav links, error 404 link, mobile footer links.
3	Accent 3 Persian Blue (#1f3ac9)	<u>Color</u> : links, error 404 link. <u>BG</u> : text line ³ , mobile toolbar. <u>Hover color</u> : search text, question + answer usernames, usernames, post information.
4	Background White (#fff)	BG: global background, lightbox, error 404 page, mobile footer Color: tooltips, preformatted text, mobile nav links (hover)
5	Borders Black (#000)	Borders, text line.
6	Text Black (#000)	BG: tooltips, preformatted text Color: global text

3.3 Selectors

There are nine selectors in the customization panel which allow you to assign a value to an element from a list of options. The table below presents these in further detail.

1	Post Width	Same as name.	XL (ideal)⁵, L, M, S, XS
2	Font Size	Same as name.	16px, 18px, 20px, 22px, 24px
3	Font	Global text.	Author, General Sans, IBM Plex Sans, Inter, Noto Sans, Open Sans, PT Sans, Raleway, Roboto, Satoshi, Source Sans Pro, Ubuntu, Work Sans
4	Code Font	Preformatted text.	IBM Plex Mono, Inconsolata, Noto Sans Mono, PT Mono, Roboto Mono, Source Code Pro, Tabular, Ubuntu Mono
5	Text Align	Same as name.	justify, left
6	Ordered List	Same as name.	decimal, lower alpha, lower roman, upper alpha, upper roman
7	Unordered List	Same as name.	circle, disc, square
8	Info Text Transform	Read more, gif source, link author, more notes.	uppercase, normal, lowercase
9	Navlink Text Transform	Nav links (sidebar + mobile).	capitalize, lowercase, normal, uppercase

3.4 Toggles

There are twelve toggles in the customization panel which allow you to disable or enable a style for an element or an entire element. The table below gives you an overview over their purposes.

Nr.	Name	Purpose	Default
1	Show Captions	Show or hide captions on the index.	inactive
2	Show Tags	Show or hide tags on the index.	active
3	Show Controls	Show or hide the controls.	inactive
4	Borders	Show or hide borders on elements.	active
5	Serif Fonts	Display non-sans-serif fonts as they are or override them with the sans-serif font from the selector Font .	active
6	Show Italics	Display italicized text as slanted or unslanted.	active
7	Colored Text	Display tumblr's colored text as colorful or override it with the color chosen from Text .	inactive
8	Custom Link [1 - 5]	Show or hide the links in the slide-in navigation and mobile drop-up navigation.	active

3.5 Text Fields

There are 19 (nineteen) text fields in the customization panel which allow you to assign a very specific value to an element. The table below gives you an overview over their purposes.

Nr.	Name	Purpose	Input
1	Photoset Gap	Spacing between the individual images of photosets.	px (recommended)
2	Lightbox Opacity ⁶	Opacity of the backgrounds of lightboxes and the slide-in navigation.	0 = transparent bg, 0 < x < 1 = opaque bg, 1 = solid bg
3	Not Found Title	Title on the Error 404 page.	text
4	Not Found Text	Text on the Error 404 page.	text
5	Link [1 - 5]	Title of the custom link.	text
6	Custom URL [1 - 5]	URL of the custom link.	URL
7	Icon [1 - 5]	Icon before custom links.	Remix Icon icons, e.g. ri-link-line.
