

Gates of Triumph - “Success expands in your life.”

Card Meaning: The gates of triumph are waiting to open deep and wide for you! Inner and outer success is coming your way! Thriving is a state of mind. Accept that you can reach any goal you desire, and even more victories will expand in your life. The more you feel it, the more love, prosperity, fame, and fortune will pour into your life.

The Sacred Traveler Wants You to Know: Arriving in a foreign hamlet, wreaths of flowers are placed around the Sacred Traveler’s shoulders. The townspeople celebrate and honor the traveler. The village elders know the challenges faced and overcome and are welcoming with open arms. If a situation knocks you over, get up and brush yourself off...and discover what you learned. You aren’t a failure if you fall down, only if you stay down. So keep going and believe in yourself. This is what true success is. Acknowledge your accomplishments in life. No matter what twists and turns there are in the road, whether you are comfortable or uncomfortable, whether you are confident or unsure . . . no matter what you are experiencing, even if your challenges seem insurmountable, feeling grateful will ease any challenge, replace darkness with light, and allow you to hear the chorus of the angels. Your entire life can transform when you take time to fully, deeply, and profoundly allow the grace of gratitude to fill you.

Great Adventure - “Take a risk; venture forward.”

Card Meaning: At the end of your life, you are more likely to regret the things you didn’t do than the things you did to. Take risks.
