

How does salvation work? There is a limitation to how deep we can go into specifics, but there are some useful details given in the Bible.

- We're *united* with Christ (Romans 6:3-8, Ephesians 2:5).
- We've experienced a *death* (Romans 6:3-8, Romans 7:4-6, Romans 8:13).
- We're given *life* (Romans 5:18, Romans 6:4, Romans 6:23, Romans 8:10-11, Ephesians 2:5, 2 Timothy 1:10).
- We're *washed* and *reborn* by the Holy Spirit (John 3:5-7, Titus 3:5).
- We're *recreated* and *made new* (Romans 6:4, Ephesians 2:10, Titus 3:5).
- We're *freed* from:
 - *Sin* (Romans 6:6-7, Romans 6:18, Romans 6:22)
 - *The Law* (Romans 7:6, Romans 8:2, Hebrews 8:13)
 - *Death* (Hebrews 2:15)
- The law is *written into* our minds and hearts (Hebrews 8:10, Hebrews 10:16).
- We're made *slaves of God and righteousness* (Romans 6:18, Romans 6:22, Hebrews 9:14).
- Our bodies will eventually be *redeemed* (Romans 8:23).
- It's *God at work*, His *gift* to us, not our own working (Romans 5:15, Romans 5:21, Romans 8:2-3, Ephesians 2:8, Philippians 2:12-13, 2 Timothy 1:9, Hebrews 8:2).
 - *It's Christ's work* that has accomplished this, establishing a new covenant into which faith can be placed.
 - Death has been *conquered* (Romans 6:9, 2 Timothy 1:10, Hebrews 2:14).
 - Sin was *condemned* in the flesh with Christ's offering (Romans 8:3).
 - Christ's humanity was important (Hebrews 2:14-18).
 - Christ's perfection was important (Hebrews 7:24-28, Hebrews 10:1-4).
 - Our sin has been *atoned for* and *forgiven* (Hebrews 2:17, Hebrews 7:27, Hebrews 8:12, Hebrews 9:12-15, Hebrews 9:22, Hebrews 9:26-28, Hebrews 10:11-12, Hebrews 10:17-18).
 - This has *justified us* and *declared us righteous* and *perfect* (Romans 5:9, Romans 5:16-19, Romans 8:4, Hebrews 10:14).
 - We've been *reconciled* to God (Romans 5:10-11).
 - Christ *intercedes* for us (Romans 8:34, Hebrews 7:25).
