Student Uniform and Dress Code:

Kalākaua Middle School's uniform *and* dress code policy is in place to promote a positive and safe environment conducive to learning. Wearing our school uniform also unites our student body, minimizes peer pressure, and fosters a strong sense of school pride and belonging.

- **Required Uniform:** The school uniform must include a Kalākaua t-shirt, grade-assigned colored lanyard, and ID.
- **Kalākaua Shirts:** Must be worn at full-length with no modifications made to them.
- **Jackets and Hoodies:** The following outerwear is allowed:
 - o A jacket or sweatshirt with a full-length zipper and a student uniform shirt underneath.
 - o An official Kalākaua uniform pullover hoodie.
 - o A non-Kalākaua uniform pullover hoodie, with a Kalākaua uniform shirt worn over the hoodie.
- **Prohibited Attire and Items:** Personal items or clothing which display, promote, or are associated with alcohol, drugs, profanity, sex, violence, or gangs (e.g. any color bandanas or bandana print clothing and accessories, any predominantly red or blue clothing, backpacks, shoes, and hats) are not allowed on campus or at any school-sponsored activity.
- **Hats:** No wearing of hats in class (outside is okay).
- **Bottoms:** Pants, shorts, and skirts must fit properly and be secured at the waist. The length of pants/shorts and skirts shall be long enough to ensure that no undergarments or posterior are showing.
- Wear solid material (no see-through materials).
- No visible underwear or undergarments.
- **Consequences for Violations:** Students not in dress code will be sent to the front office and will receive a loaner uniform shirt or shorts.
- Non-Kalākaua hoodies worn without a Kalākaua uniform shirt over the hoodie will be confiscated and held in the office for the remainder of the day.
- Students who are repeatedly out of dress code may receive detention, have a parent conference with an administrator, or receive other consequences following Chapter 19.
