

My Perspective on the Leah Situation:

Hey there, my name is Nolan, and I am Eddie's (Simpleflips) long-time editor and friend. Being someone who has gotten a unique perspective on this situation I thought I'd share my side of the story, and give more insight to what is happening.

Let's get this out of the way first, I know I'm putting my own reputation on the line to tell you this, and the truth is that Eddie is the victim in this. I will not be handling this as cautiously and respectfully as Eddie did and won't dance around anything. Leah is being delusional and has convinced herself that she's the victim. She deserves what's coming to her.

To Summarize:

1. Leah was abusive. I know how tough that may be to swallow, but it's true. Eddie has come to stay at my place for weeks at a time so he wouldn't have to be near her, and has opened up to me about how he's worried she knows where he lives and doesn't feel safe.
2. Leah's document is full of bullshit. I'm of course referring to **"The intention of this document is not to cancel or ruin anybody's career."** and **"Please do not attack, or harass anybody involved in these conversations."** as that was the very first thing she did afterward, consistently pushing for people to see it and contacting everybody Eddie knows to turn them against him (Including Bre). Leah also lies SO MUCH in her document, and nearly all of it is missing context.
3. There was no "Power Dynamic" believing that a person with 30k subs on youtube currently working at IBM can't date anyone that isn't famous is beyond stupid. Leah's not a child who's at risk of manipulation in this situation, she's an adult who fell in love. That's on her. She lied about not being in a relationship when she met Eddie and it's not his fault that she lied. (sounds very reliable already I know)
4. Bre is still Eddie's friend. Leah makes some crazy accusations that Eddie "used his power dynamic" to manipulate Bre as well. As you may have read in Leah's own posts, Eddie was only interested in them as a friend. **AND STILL IS.** That's right, he hasn't gotten into a relationship with this person months after the breakup, because they are simply an important friend Eddie made through his community. Which I may remind you that almost every person involved with Eddie's videos were found the same way.

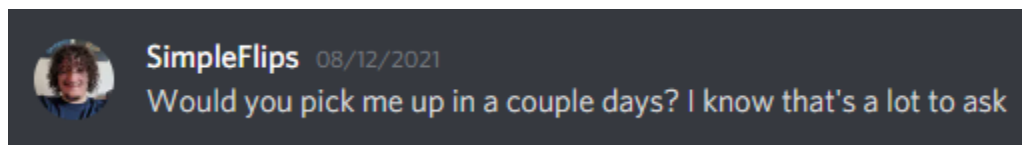
(I suppose we were all manipulated though right?)

The Abuse:

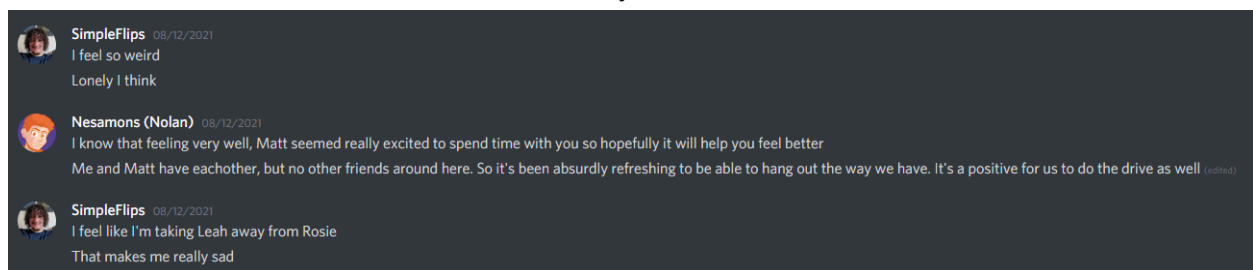
While I don't have direct proof of this through messages, I do have a lot of personal experiences, being his editor when he shared his difficulties with Leah to me a lot clicked into place. For example, I'd be editing a Green Demon video, and he'd be smiling and laughing, in a perfect mood, and I'd see his face shift. Suddenly pausing whatever attempt he was and then leaving for hours at a time, not even pausing the recording, then when he got back, he'd usually try to finish and in some cases just end the recording without saying anything, in a completely sour mood. I now know this aligned with the disagreements he had with Leah.

Now from a viewer's perspective of Leah's document, you may think that Simple "manipulated" or "abused her emotionally" by stopping her from streaming. But in reality she forgot to mention her financial situation at the time. Have you ever had a roommate who doesn't pay rent? Maybe you don't kick them out, and just have them pick up some of the slack if you can afford it right? I'm sorry to tell you, but by Leah's dictionary that is abuse. Leah was mooching ENTIRELY off of Eddie, she forced herself into his home, paid nothing and refused to get a job, nor did she do any chores. Eddie provided EVERYTHING. When you are in a relationship, you are allowed to have conditions, that is not abuse. Eddie being honest with his feelings and worries about the relationship is healthy. One of the moment's Eddie shared with me was Leah crying her eyes out, telling him how much she HATED streaming and how much it stressed her out. So let's not act like Eddie telling her he wasn't comfortable with her streaming wasn't justified.

Now, back when Leah and Eddie split up for good I got an urgent message from him.



We could tell something was up so I had Matt go pick him up, since I was visiting family at home when he had asked. Here were his very first concerns to me.



He opened up to us on this trip, and explained the Bre situation in great detail, and his true thoughts on it. I had heard about it before, but I got to understand his perspective. He described to me how Leah forced him to write that message to them, and make that tweet word-for-word. Another thing that Leah lied about in her document. Notice the timestamps here, Eddie told me this 2 months before Leah "wrongly" apologized for it, during a time where they

weren't talking. The stories line up exactly, but now she's taking it back, as if that's not what really happened.

Leah is using the fact that she lost an endless meal ticket as an excuse to be a victim, and it's disgusting.

Which leads me to...

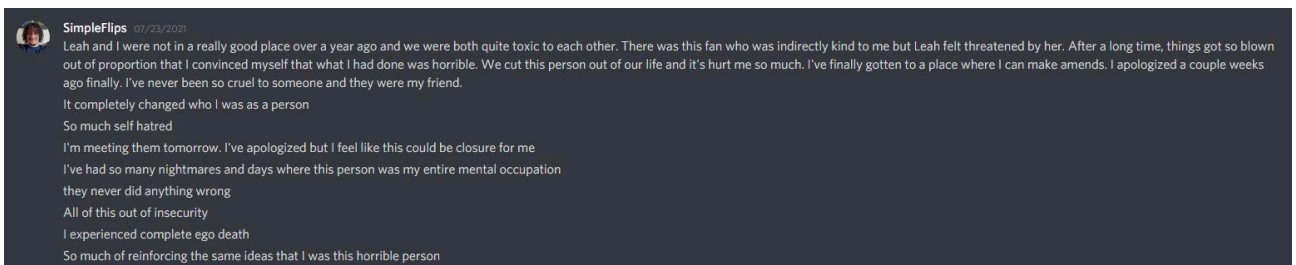
The Bullshit:

If you want to see someone who's been manipulated, all you need to do is look in a mirror. Leah lies and paints Eddie in such a bad light from the very start of her document. Let's go over the line **"The intention of this document is not to cancel or ruin anybody's career."** because let's not kid ourselves: this is what she's trying to do. From my personal experience with Leah (Because Eddie never hid her from us and let her hang out in our group chats) I know Leah is very aware of cancel culture, and had also explained a distaste for it. So the idea that she just "wouldn't know" that this could ruin Eddie's life is laughable.

She does know, using alts to make sure people see it, and contacting his friends about it. She wants to destroy his public and personal life. Since posting, she's been trying to "win over" his friends, this includes real life friends, and online ones. Imagine getting calls and messages from so many of your friends, having to tell them your side of the story over and over again, reliving the abuse. This is not the mark of someone who wants to "Just be heard" and "accepts fault for their side of things" This is someone trying to ruin his life.

Additionally most of her points in her document stem from her believing that Eddie had feelings for Bre, and that he cheated. This is objectively false, and is a recent narrative she's convinced herself of.

Leah knew he was going, and was okay with it. That alone takes away credibility for that ENTIRE section of her document where she says she told him not to go. Are you seeing a pattern here? Eddie also told me this in private before trying to meet them.

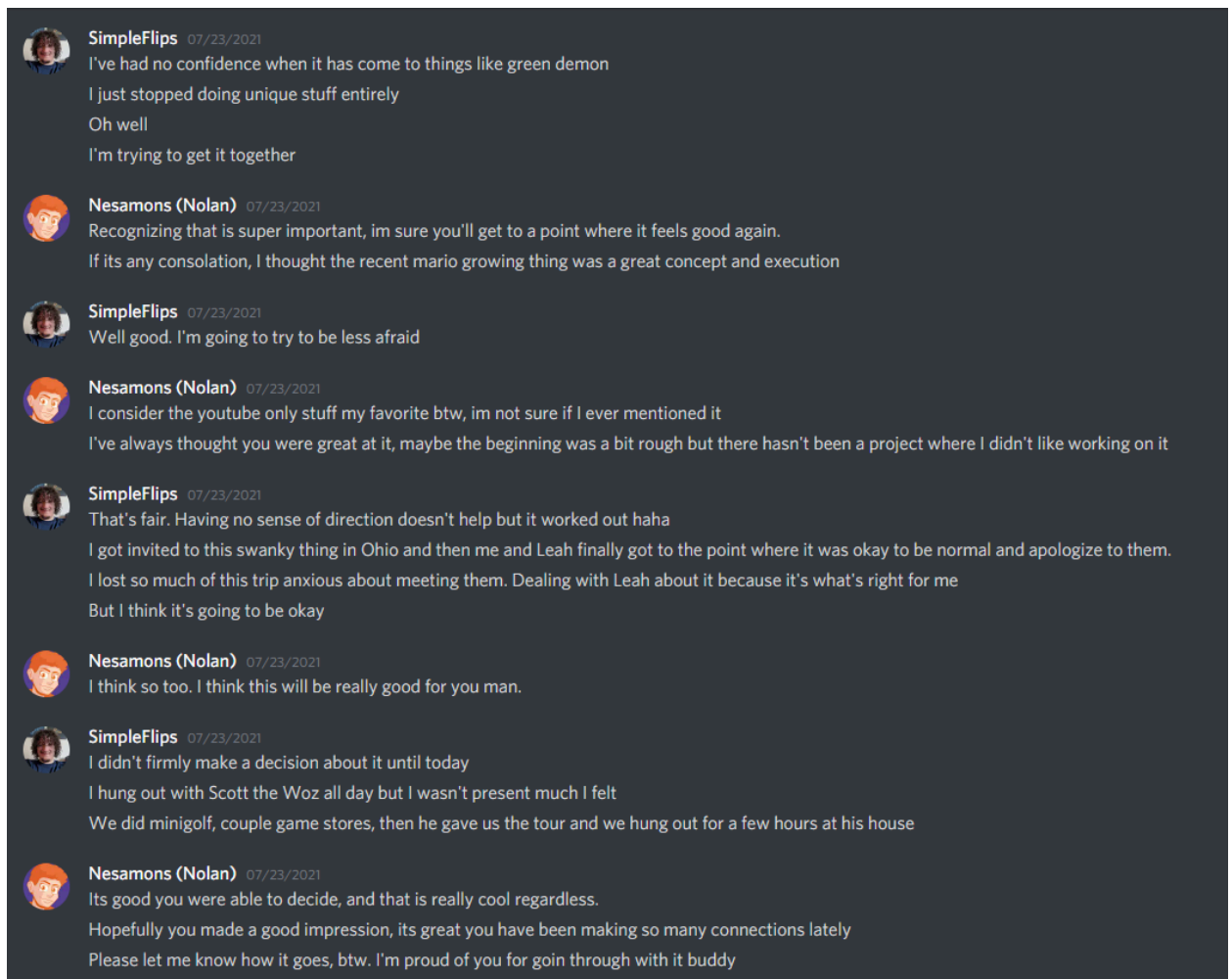

He even told me that they got to a place where it was okay, and even when sharing this to me he tried to protect Leah. (Clearly the mark of an abuser right?)

The Power Dynamic and Bre:

Combining these together because I feel they are directly related. If there is a “Power Dynamic” between Leah and Eddie, then people with hobbies don’t deserve love. Eddie wasn’t making enough from youtube to support himself when they met, that should be enough for you to go “Oh this probably isn’t my business” and recognize that this is a normal relationship. Not to mention when they met it was fully public, you can literally go in his discord and find it. No one had an issue with it for FOUR YEARS. Let’s combine that with the recurring cast of people that shows up in Eddie’s videos. Are these people other big creators? No.

They are fans. Hark, Mark, Foxen, Me, Matt, Vic, Dawn, Lumi, Anisa, Tub, Network, Bolding, ALL OF THEM. We ALL started as fans. Eddie has been **praised** from the methods he interacts with his fans, allowing them to play some TTT with us if he needs an extra player, or Valorant, or Minecraft, or CS:GO. Occasionally we’d have a lot of fun with that fan and hang out with them more often. It was legitimately possible to get into the friend group through this

method, and most of us did. Where is the line between “Power Dynamic” and “Active with Fans” Because if Leah was abused through that then *oh no*, ALL OF US HAVE. Better stop laughing at funny moments with us having a great time together because we’re all abused too right? You can create friendships online and in this case it became more than that. As for Bre, just because they (looked) female (to Leah (who misgendered them constantly)) they were the target.

Bre was not manipulated by anyone other than Leah, and Leah is **still** trying to manipulate them. Even now messaging them privately trying to make sure they abandon Eddie, but they have made up since, and are on great terms. Eddie isn’t trying to make a relationship out of them, and Bre doesn’t feel manipulated by him even after the document. Who’s word is more solid? Bre’s? Or Leah?

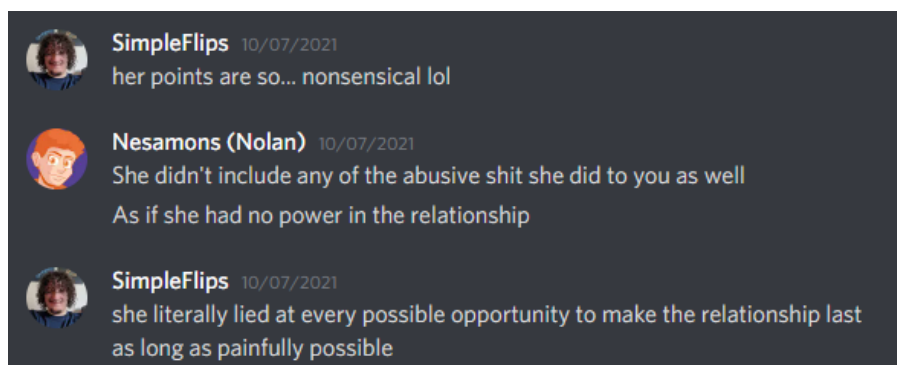
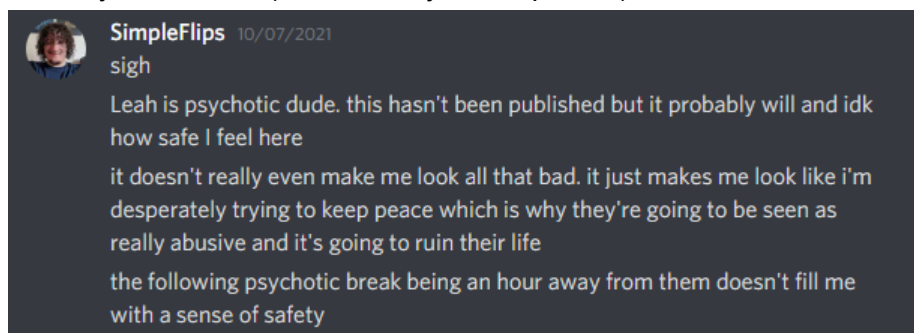
Conclusion:

Leave Eddie alone, he’s been through enough.
