

Corunna Middle School Announcements - Thursday, March 5, 2020

Swim Team: The middle school swim and dive team finished up their season last night and on Tuesday at the Middle School League Invitational. The team performed well competing against club teams from the area as well as other middle school teams. The team finished 5th this year, improving from last year. There were 10 teams and over 200 swimmers last night with over 71 heats. The team had some major time drops to help the program take steps forward. The dive team of Emma Kirkey and Lexi Golab started off on Tuesday night. Emma placed 2nd and Lexi finished 9th. The medley relay team of Gross, Kett, Earl, and Meyer started Wednesday off with an 8th place finish to grab a medal. Amy Vovsko swam to a top 8 finish in the 200 freestyle and teammate Nolan Carr placed 11th to also medal and score for Corunna. In the 100 IM Lillia Reid placed 13th. The 50 freestyle saw Gus Hannah swim to a medal by placing 11th. In the 50 fly Lillia Reid came back to get her 2nd medal by placing 9th followed by teammate Caden Earl who also medaled by placing 11th. In the 100 freestyle Corunna's Gus Hannah and Amy Vovsko took home medals. The 200 relay team of Hannah, Shay, Carr and Vovsko placed 6th. Charlie Gross came away with a medal in the 100 back. Riley Kett swam in the 100 breast to place 12th to pick up the medal. The 400 relay team of Hannah, Vovsko, Shay and Carr placed 3rd to finish off the successful night.
